
• Conveniently located in between Illinois Medical District (IMD) and University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC) campus.

- Easily accessible to public transportation via the CTA's Blue and Pink "L" lines. The property also sits along the CTA's 157 bus route (Streeterville/Taylor).




### Area Description
