Village Audiology is a satellite location providing adult hearing evaluation services initially and primarily to the veteran population scheduled through VA agencies. It will eventually be providing additional services through private insurance once it is credentialed, including hearing aid fittings, full audiograms, and middle ear testing including tympanometry and acoustic reflexes.

Compassionate Care Hospice in Milford gives patients facing a terminal illness the freedom to live each day to its fullest by offering comfort, dignity, quality of life and time. Compassionate Care Hospice works in close coordination with patients, their families and their doctor to deliver high-quality hospice care around the clock.

Champions for Children's Mental Health is a family-run, non-profit organization providing Family Peer Support services to families throughout Delaware. Family Peer Support Services are formal and informal services and supports provided to families raising children who experience social, emotional, medical, developmental, substance use and/or behavioral challenges in their home, school, and/or community. Family Peer Support provides a structured, strength-based relationship between a Family Support Peer (FSP) and the parent/caregiver for the benefit of the child.

Delaware Assistive Technology Initiative (DATI) led by the Center for Disabilities Studies at the University of Delaware, helps people learn about AT options and acquire the devices that can support them at work, school, home and in the community. DATI demonstrations compare features and benefits of particular devices. Loans let people borrow AT devices that can aid decision-making, fill a gap while the person is waiting for device repair or funding, provide a short-term accommodation, or provide the opportunity to become familiar with a product's operation. DATI also offers programs that provide assistive technology at no cost to individuals who have no other means to obtain it.

The Delaware Network for Excellence in Autism (DNEA), a program of the Center for Disabilities Studies at the University of Delaware, offers training and technical assistance that benefits individuals with autism, their families, and the professionals who serve them.

Easterseals Delaware & Maryland's Eastern Shore offers a variety of exceptional services throughout the state, including: children's therapies, day programs for adults with physical or intellectual disabilities, supported employment, senior services, personal attendant services, recreational camping, respite services, and services for caregivers. Our Community Outreach Program is based at the Milford Wellness Village to provide resources, information and case management for those caring for a loved one with a disability, chronic illness or aging condition.
