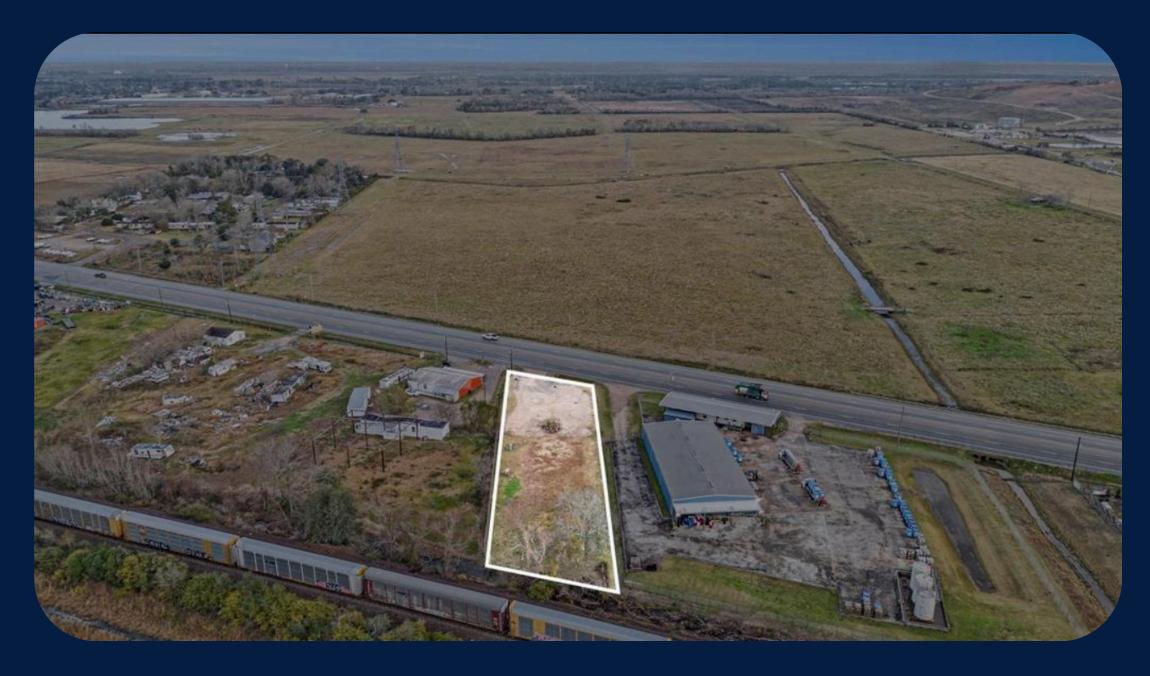

TYPES OF REAL ESTATELICENSEHOLDERS:

- · A BROKER is responsible for all brokerage ac OviOes, including acts performed by sales agents sponsored by the broker.
- · A SALES AGENT must be sponsored by a broker and works with clients on behalf of the broker.

A BROKER'SMINIMUMDUTIESREQUIREDBYLAW(Aclientisthepersonorpartythatthebrokerrepresents):

- · Put the interests of the client above all others, including the broker's own interests;
- · Inform the client of any material informa\text{O} on about the property or transac\text{O} on received by the broker;
- Answer the client's quesOons and present any offer to or counter-offer from the client; and
- Treat all pares to a real estate transaceon honestly and fairly.

A LICENSE HOLDER CAN REPRESENT A PARTY IN A REAL ESTATE TRANSACTION:

AS AGENT FOR OWNER (SELLER/LANDLORD): The broker becomes the property owner's agent through an agreement with the owner, usually in a wriΣenlisΘngto sellor propertymanagementagreement. Anowner's agent must perform the broker's minimum duθes above and must inform the owner of anymaterial inform aθon about the property or transacθonk nown by the agent, including inform aθon disclosed to the agent or subagent by the buyer or buyer's agent fees are not set by law and are fully negoθable.

The broker becomes the buyer/tenant's agent by agreeing to represent the buyer, usually through a weixer representation and agreement. A buyer's agent must perform the broker's minimum dues above and must inform the buyer of any material information about the property or transaction known by the agent, including information disclosed to the agent by the seller or seller's agent. A buyer/tenant's agent fees are not set by law and are fully negotable.

AS AGENT FOR BOTH - INTERMEDIARY: To act as an intermediary between the parθes the broker must first obtain the wriΣen

agreement of each party to the transacθon. The wriΣen agreement must state who will pay the broker and, in conspicuous bold or underlined print, set forth the broker's obligaθons as an intermediary. A broker who acts as an intermediary:

- · Must treat all parOes to the transacOon imparOally and fairly;
- · May, with the parθes' wriΣen consent, appoint a different license holder associated with the broker to each party (owner and buyer) to communicate with, provide opinions and advice to, and carry out the instrucθons of each party to the transacθon. · Must not, unless specifically authorized in wriθng to do so by the party, disclose:
 - \circ that the owner will accept a price less than the wri Σ en asking price;
 - that the buyer/tenant will pay a price greater than the price submixed in a wrixen offer; and
 - any confiden Oal information or any other information that a party specifically instructs the broker in writing not to disclose, unless required to do so by law.

AS SUBAGENT: A license holder acts as a subagent when aiding a buyer in a transac\to on without an agreement to represent the buyer. A subagent can assist the buyer but does not represent the buyer and must place the interests of the owner first. TO AVOID DISPUTES, ALL AGREEMENTS BETWEEN YOU ANDA BROKER SHOULDBEIN WRITING ANDCLEARLY ESTABLISH:

- · The broker's duOes and responsibiliOes to you, and your obligaOons under the representaOon agreement.
- · Who will pay the broker for services provided to you, when payment will be made and how the payment will be calculated.
