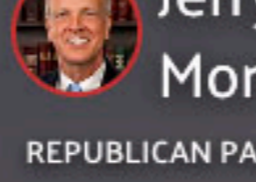

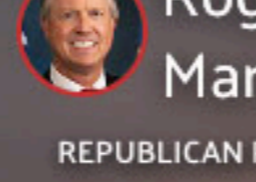

From 2020 to 2021, employment in Abilene, KS grew at a rate of 3.79%, from 3.2k employees to 3.32k employees.

The most common employment sectors for those who live in Abilene, KS, are Health Care & Social Assistance (745 people), Manufacturing (523 people), and Educational Services (309 people). 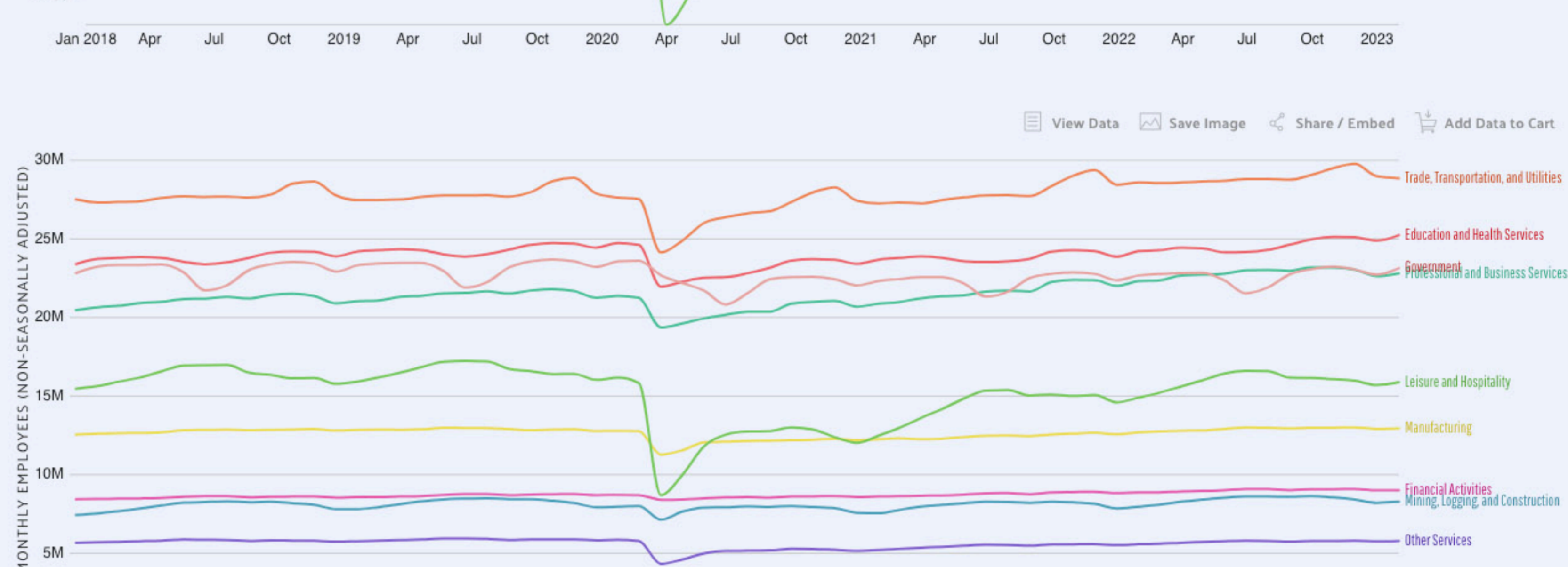
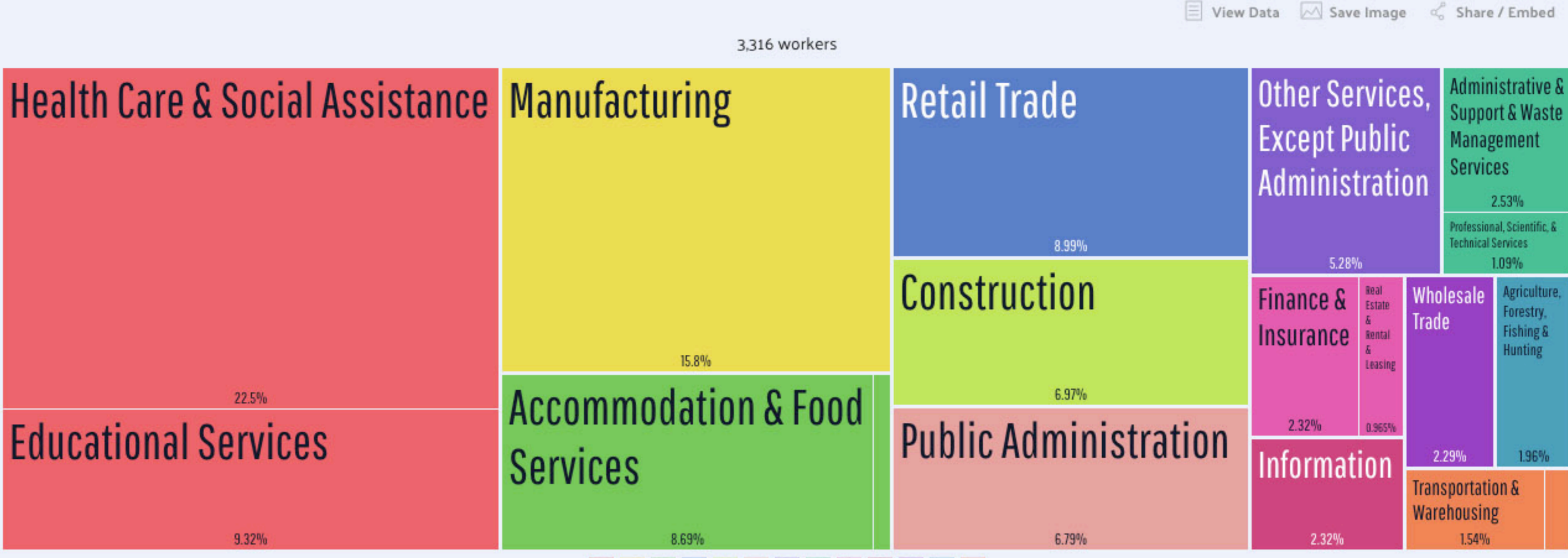

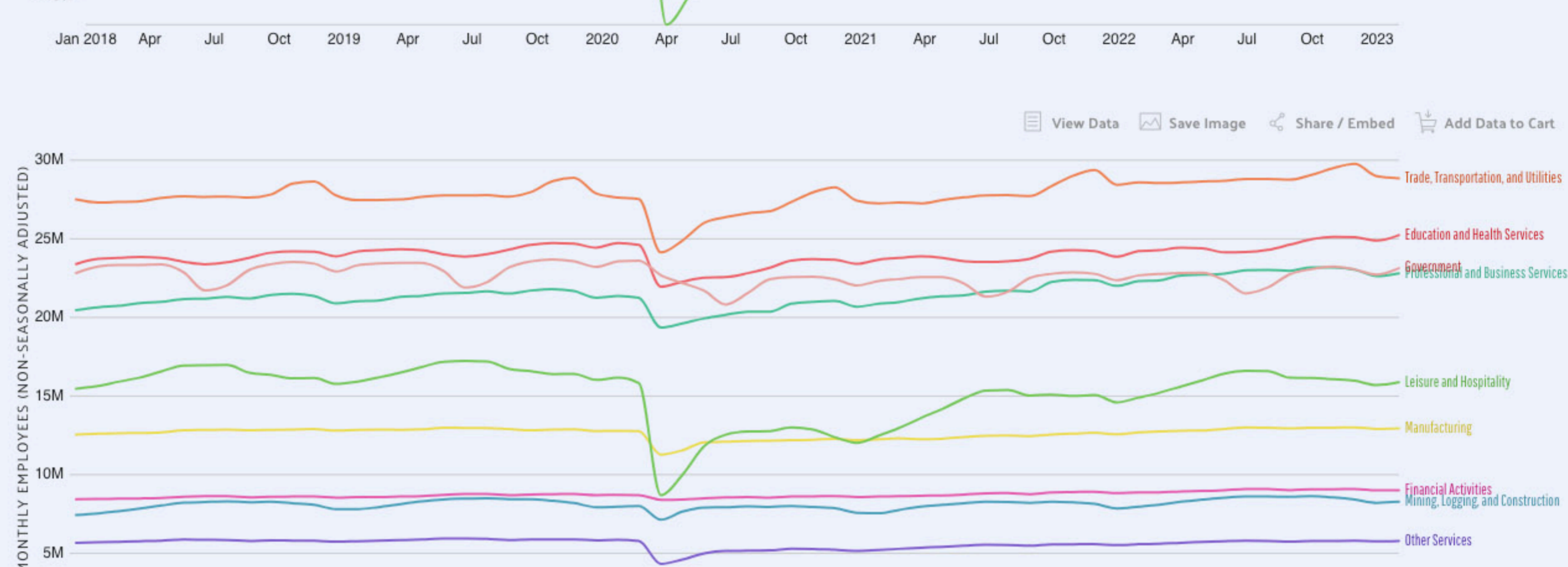

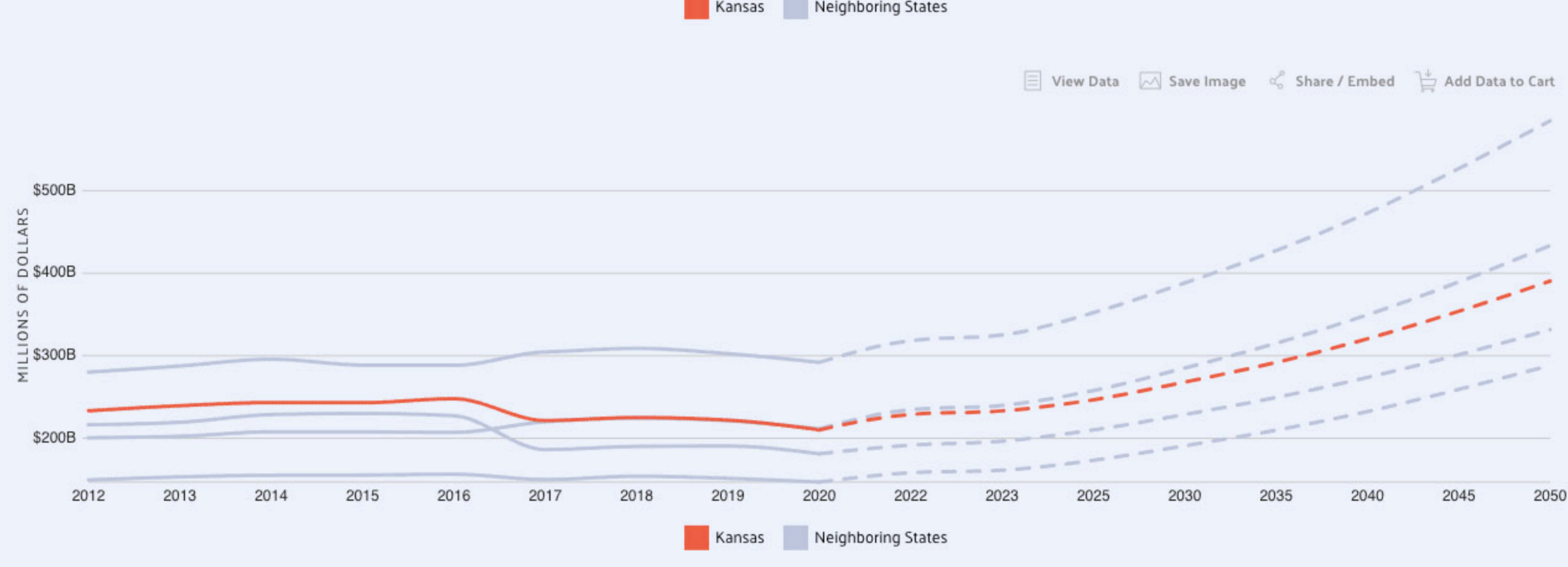

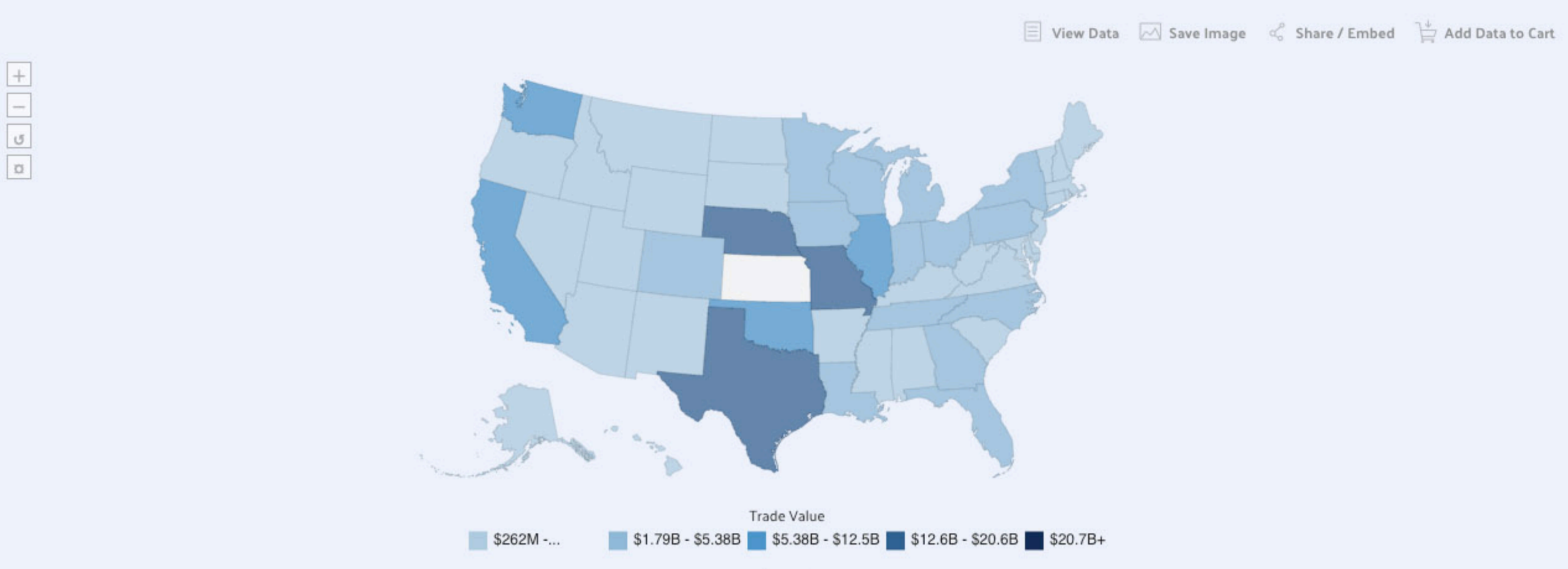

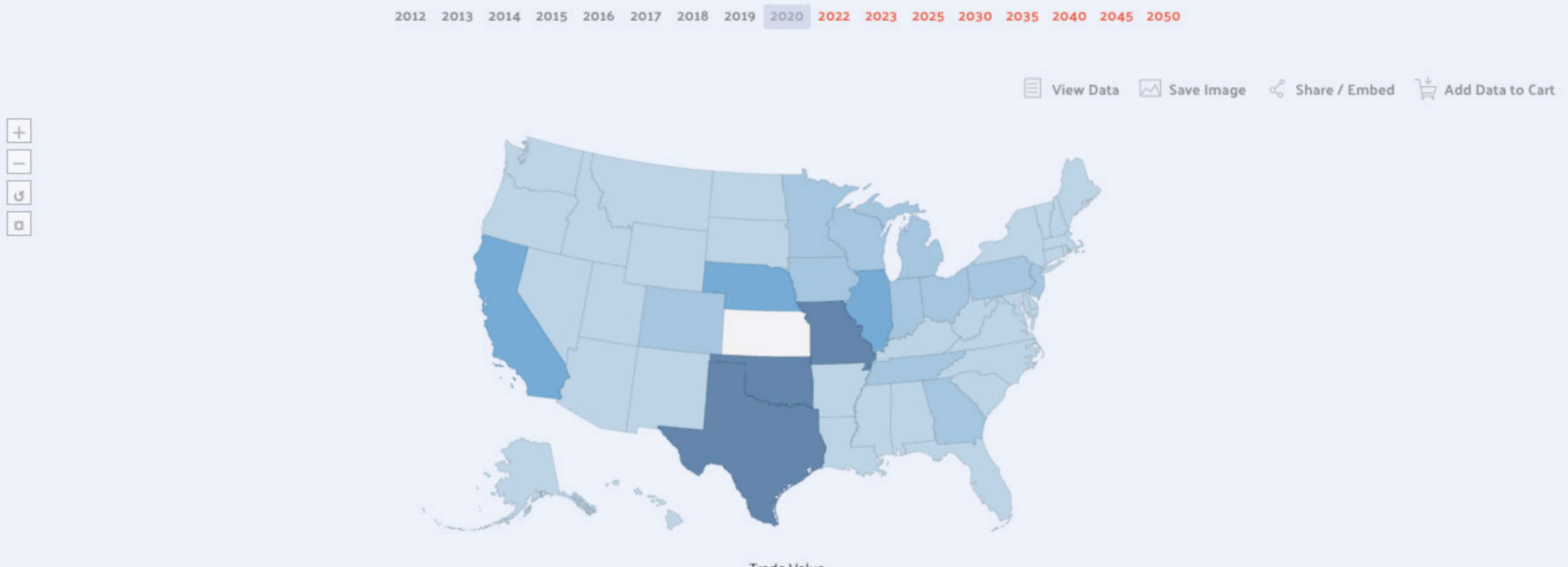

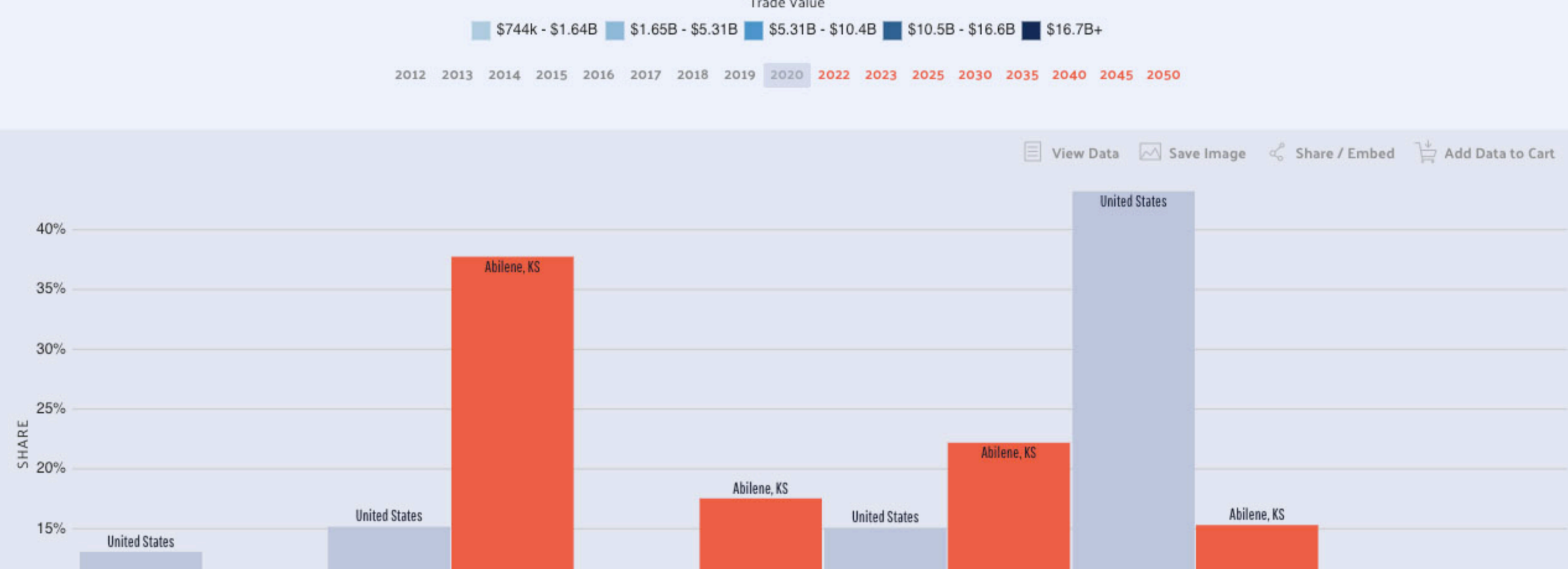

The closest comparable wage GINI for Abilene, KS is from Kansas.

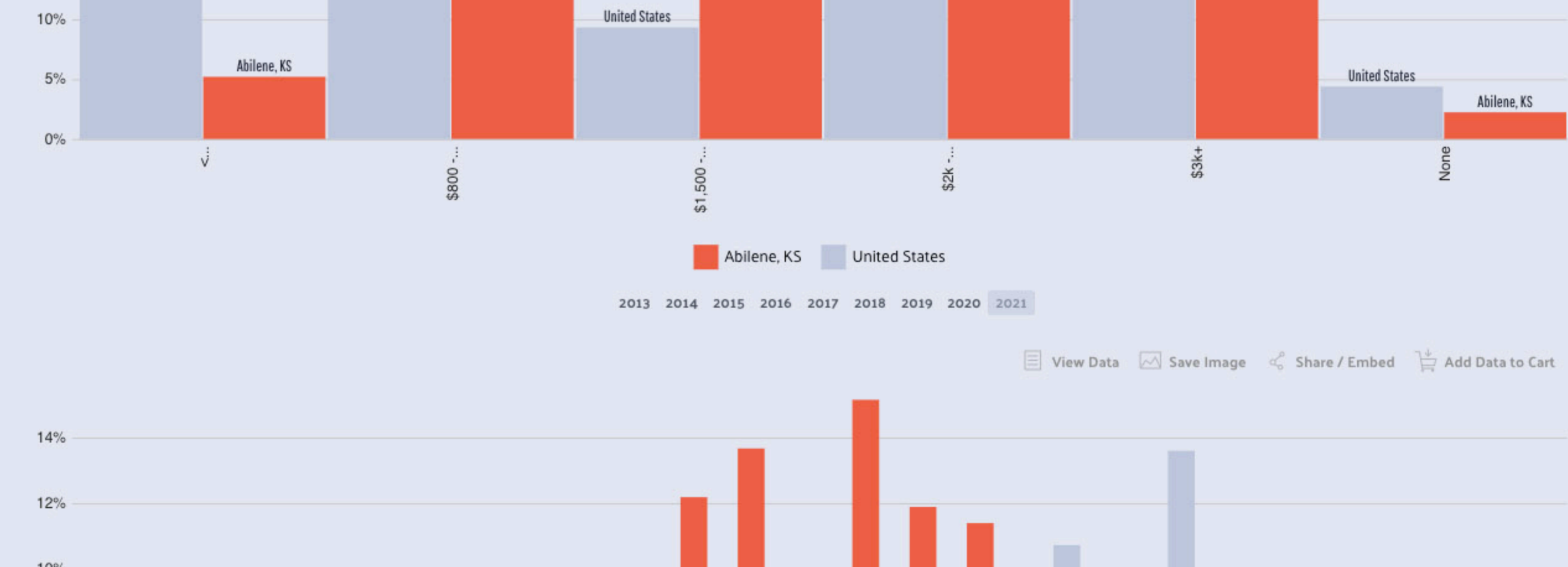

In 2021, the income inequality in Kansas was 0.46 according to the GINI calculation of the wage distribution. Income inequality had a 0.555% growth from 2020 to 2021, which means that wage distribution grew somewhat less even. The GINI for Kansas was lower than that the national average of 0.478. In other words, wages are distributed more evenly in Kansas in comparison to the national average.

Commuter Transportation

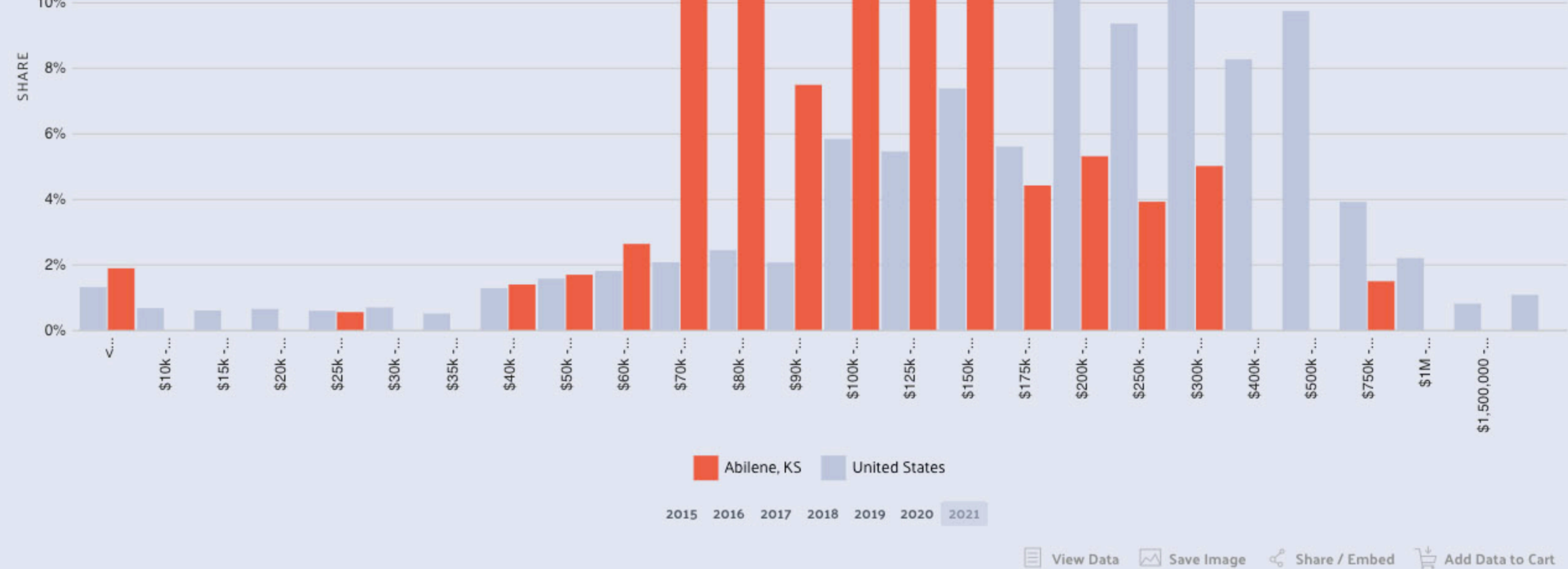

In 2021, 70% of workers in Abilene, KS drove alone to work, followed by those who carpooled to work (14.6%) and those who worked at home (9.11%).

Using averages, employees in Abilene, KS have a shorter commute time (16.4 minutes) than the normal US worker (26.8 minutes). Additionally, 0.868% of the workforce in Abilene, KS have "super commuters" in excess of 90 minutes.

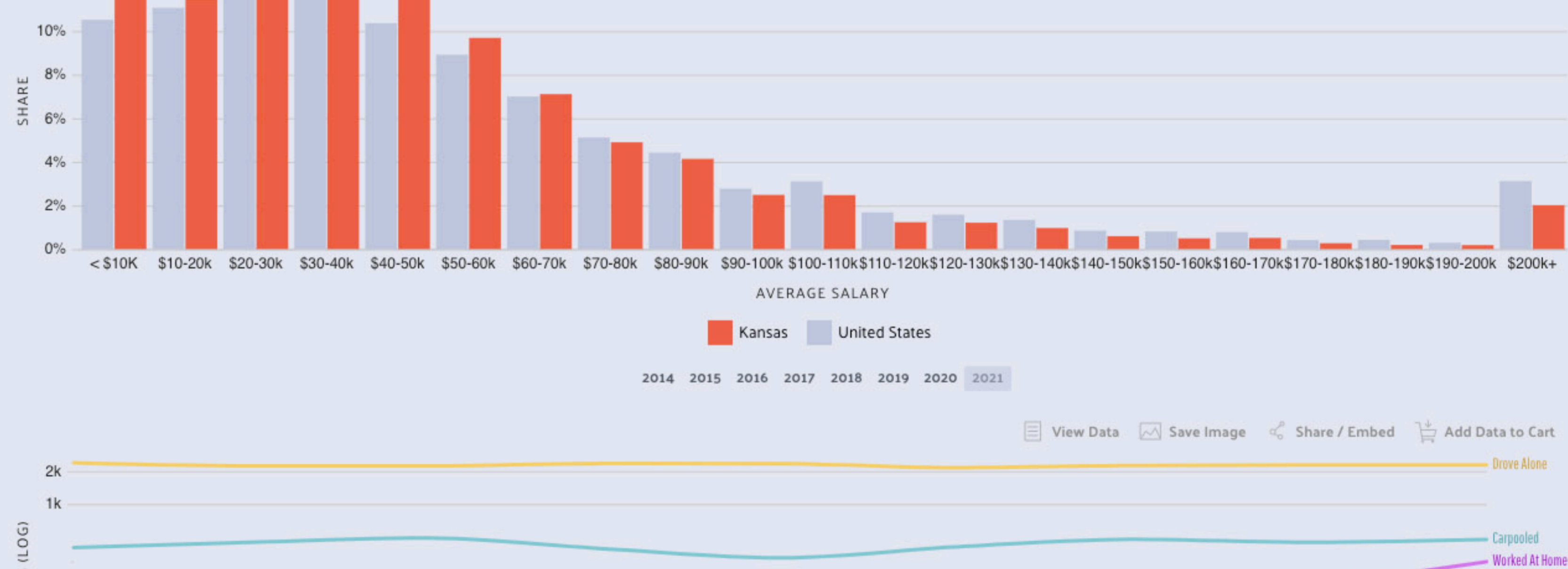


Car Ownership

Health Care Diversity

Age Range

In 2021, insured persons according to age ranges were distributed in 23.4% under 18 years, 14.5% between 18 and 34 years, 41% between 35 and 64 years, and 21.2% over 64 years.
