EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Axis Realty Group is pleased to present the opportunity for ownership of Harvest House, a unique combination of prime retail property and established entertainment business located just a few blocks from the historic Denton Square. The site includes a 3,075-square-foot main building, 1,800-square-foot covered pavilion, and 600-square-foot outdoor stage, creating one of the most recognizable live music and bar venues in North Texas. For over a decade, Harvest House has served as a cultural anchor in the Denton community, known for its rotating craft beer taps, full cocktail bar, extensive non-alcoholic offerings, live music programming, outdoor fire pit seating, and vibrant atmosphere. The business, which recently celebrated its 10-year anniversary, is offered alongside the real estate and includes strong brand equity, seasoned staff, and consistent operating income. This is an ideal opportunity for an owner-operator or investor seeking a hospitality asset with deep local roots and significant upside in a high-growth urban submarket.

BUSINESS OVERVIEW

Just steps from the Denton Square, in the heart of the city's arts and entertainment district. The property is perfectly positioned for events like Arts & Jazz Fest, Day of the Dead, and Denton's growing Halloween and festival culture. The atmosphere offers multiple "experiences" in one place:

- **Large open-air backyard** with fire pits, dart boards, shaded seating and an expansive covered pavilion equipped with gas radiant heaters for year-round comfort.
- **Indoor bar and seating** with 54 rotating taps and a full cocktail menu, including exclusive specialty drinks.
- **A prominent stage** visible from the entire venue, hosting live music from local and regional acts to big bands and jazz.
- **Side yard food** court anchored by Media Luna Mexican Kitchen (operated by a third party under a lease agreement).



COMMUNITY EVENTS

From live music to weddings, baby showers, markets, School of Rock shows, and family-friendly Sunday jazz afternoons, Harvest House is designed to bring people together. Daytime hours are kid- and dog-friendly; nighttime is 21+.

A seasoned, loyal staff, many of whom have been there since day one, including an operations manager, beverage manager, events coordinator, shift managers, and a dedicated sound engineering crew that delivers consistently high-quality experiences.

Harvest House began as a family project inspired one of the family's sons, a UNT graduate and experienced and degreed audio engineer. Since opening in March 2015, the business has grown into a Denton institution known for its welcoming environment, eclectic programming, and live music. Events range from jazz bands to weddings and vendor markets. The team includes long-standing managers and stage crew.

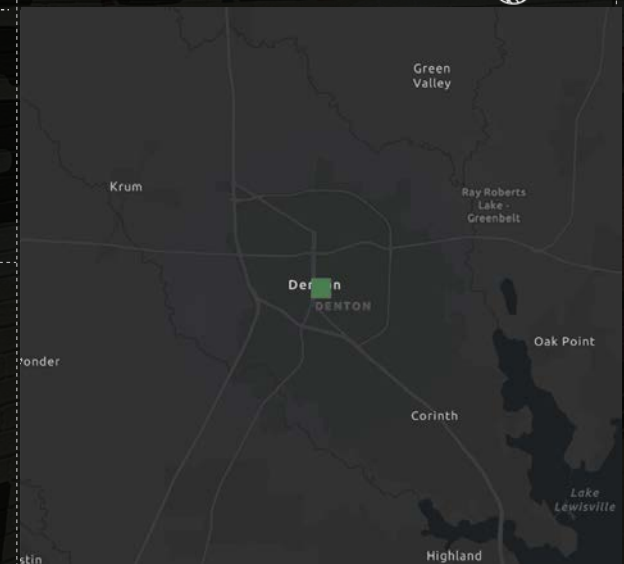
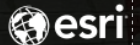
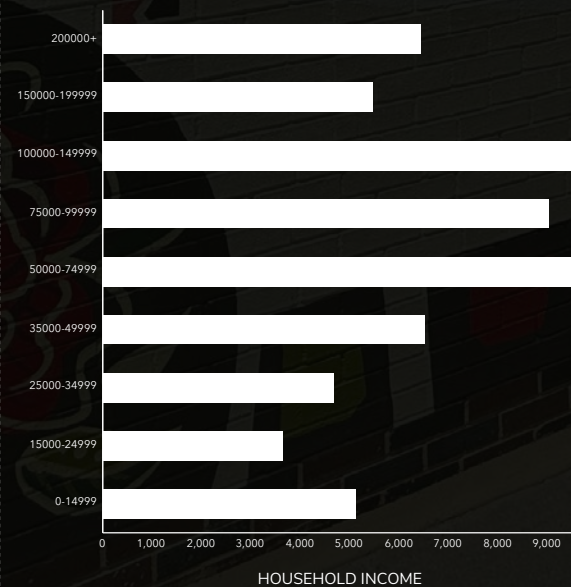
