## LOCATION DESCRIPTION

The EDC reports the County has the 4th highest median household income, 7th fastest growing population in the state of Florida, 2.5% per year population growth over the past 10 years, and 1,500 new single-family homes will be needed annually to meet projected population growth. Santa Rosa County is home to NAS Whiting Field, the largest air wing in the U.S. Navy and produces 100% of all Navy, Marine Corps and Coast Guard helicopter pilots. The wing also conducts 60% of Chief of Naval Air Training (CNATRA) command's primary flight training, supporting more than 1.5 million annual flight operations. The installation currently hosts 6 Training Squadrons and 2 Instructor Squadrons and is the busiest installation in the world.

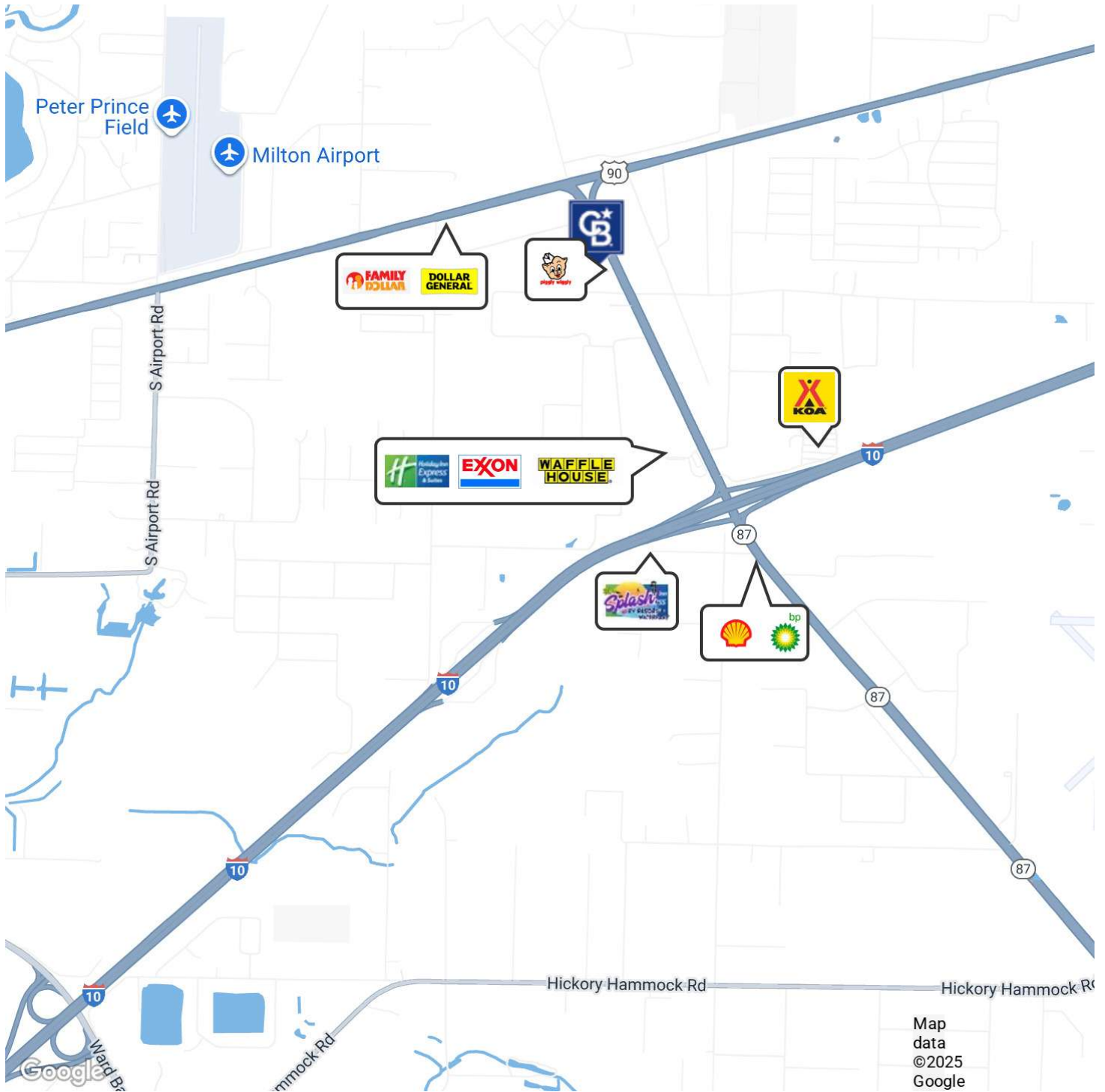
