WILMINGTON INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

An easy 15-minute drive from Center Point, Wilmington International Airport is served by five airlines offering 14 non-stop flights and access to over 360 destinations.

DEMAND DRIVERS

Mayfaire Town Center

Wilmington Riverwalk

One of the best ways to explore downtown Wilmington is by way of the Wilmington Riverwalk. Spanning nearly two miles, the riverwalk is lined with boutique shops, river-view dining, relaxing green spaces, pedestrian art and a variety of river cruises departing from docks along the Cape Fear River. Veer off to explore the local shops and restaurants within the historic Cotton Exchange or the Chandler's Warf Warehouse Shops and Galleries.

Battleship North Carolina

The Battleship North Carolina Memorial was opened to the public in October 1961 as an authentically restored World War II battleship, a National Historic Landmark, a museum, and a memorial honoring North Carolinians of all branches of service who gave their lives in World War II.


Wrightsville Beach

Landfall


