Beloeil is easily accessible, with major highways such as Highway 20 and Routes 223, 229, and 116 linking the city to surrounding regions. The city's residents benefit from a range of educational and health services, including five French-language elementary schools, one English-language elementary school, a French-language high school, a CLSC, and a CHSLD. Strategically positioned, Beloeil's industrial zone enjoys a prime location along Highway 20, with easy access to Highways 30 and 10 as well as Route 116, making it an ideal hub for business and commerce.
