LOCATION


Located at the prime intersection of Maggio and Menvielle Road, this corner lot offers a strategic location ideal for a gas station and convenience store. The property is situated less than a mile from the Calexico East Port of Entry, one of the busiest border crossings in the United States, which guarantees a high volume of daily traffic and excellent visibility for any business established here. The lot's accessibility will be further enhanced by a planned four-way signalized intersection, which will provide seamless entry and exit points for vehicles heading to and from the border.

UTILITIES & INFRASTRUCTURE

The property has been fully graded and is construction-ready. All utilities, including water, sewer, electricity, phone and natural gas, have already been brought to the site.

LEGAL & ENTITLEMENTS

The property has already received approval and entitlements for the development of a gas station and convenience store. Finalizing the development is subject to design review and the issuance of building permits.











MASTER SITE PLAN


