





### **AREA OVERVIEW**

### SWANTON, OHIO

- A small, tight-knit village located in both Fulton and Lucas counties of northwestern Ohio
  - 20 miles southwest of Toledo; 75 miles southwest of Detroit, MI; 85 miles northeast of Fort Wayne, IN
- 4,133 residents in the incorporated village limits; 14,000+ residents in the 43558 zip code
- 93 million people accessible within 500 miles of the village; centrally located in the "ChiPitts Megalopolis"

### ECONOMY

- The local economy is largely supported by agriculture, manufacturing, and small businesses
- Its location along the Ohio Turnpike (I-80/90) facilitates trade and commuting
- Eugene F. Kranz Toledo Express Airport Serves as a hub of economic activity in northwest Ohio by supporting manufacturing, military, air cargo, aviation training and education, commercial service aviation, and general aviation operations
  - \$581 million in annual economic output throughout the Toledo region; supports nearly 3,000 jobs
  - Located 3 miles from Swanton
- Cannaley Treehouse Village A popular attraction located in Oak Openings Preserve, the largest park in the network of Metroparks Toledo which together generates \$60+ million in direct visitor spending across all parks
  - Consists of 4 treehouses and 3 elevated campsites for overnight stays
- 1,870 workers in the village; 72% white-collar jobs vs. 28% blue-collar jobs
- \$77,000 average household income paired with a cost of living 21% below the national average

### DEVELOPMENTS

• Metroparks Expansion - Acquisition of an additional 113 acres of land by Metroparks Toledo in the Oak Openings Preserve which includes a pre-existing campground on the property

 Superior Made RV Resort - Renovation and rebranding of the pre-existing Big Sandy Campground to include refurbished campsites, a swimming pool, pickleball/volleyball courts, 2 new bathhouses, kayak access, and access to Oak Openings Preserve from the campground; construction to begin in 2026
