



CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- (a) The source on which the rights are granted is the South Thompson River.
- (b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- (c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 17th March, 1995.
- (d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is irrigation.
- (e) The maximum quantity of water that may be diverted is 1,650 acre feet per annum.
- (f) The period of the year during which water may be used is 1st April to 30th September.
- (g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Block B of Sections 29, and 32, Block B of Sections 28 and 33, Block C of Section 27, and Block D of Section 28, all part of Township 19, Range 15, West of the 6th Meridian, Kamloops Division Yale District, of which 700 acres may be irrigated.
- (h) The authorized works are diversion structure, pumps, pipe, balancing reservoir and sprinkler system, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- (i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- (j) This licence is issued pursuant to the provisions of the *Water Act* to ensure compliance with that statute, which makes it an offence to divert or use water from a stream in British Columbia without proper authorization. It is the responsibility of the licensee to ensure that all activities conducted under this authorization are carried out with regard to the rights of third parties, and comply with other applicable legislation that may be in force.
- (k) This licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence 112174.



- (b) The approximate dimensions of the Crown land authorized to be occupied under this permit are 200 feet (61 metres) in length by 15 feet (4.6 metres) in width for an area of 0.07 acre (0.03 hectare).
- (c) Prior to the cutting or destruction of any timber, necessary to permit construction and maintenance of the said works, the permittee shall apply for and obtain a licence to cut timber from the Ministry of Forests, District Manager. The amount of stumpage, royalty and/or compensation payable to the Crown in respect of trees, including merchantable or young growth, cut, removed, damaged, or destroyed by the permittee, shall be the sum or sums fixed by the Forest Service of the Province of British Columbia.




