With 15 diverse tenants, including anchor tenants such as Michaels, Harbor Freight, and Walk-On's (which has a new roof), the center maintains a high occupancy rate of 98.1%, leaving only a 1,500 square foot space vacant. The center is strategically positioned on US Highway 98, a major retail corridor with a traffic count exceeding 63,000 vehicles per day, ensuring excellent visibility and accessibility. Additionally, the property includes 300 parking spaces, enhancing convenience for shoppers. The deal comes with an assumable non-recourse loan, providing financial flexibility for prospective buyers.

The property is in Hattiesburg, Mississippi, known as the "Hub City," and is a vibrant and growing community with a rich history and a dynamic economy. 




