

Location Map








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

Currently, 50.7% of the 86,733 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 40.1%, renter occupied; and 9.3% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.3% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.2% are renter occupied; and 11.5% are vacant. In 2010, there were 83,374 housing units in the area - 53.4% owner occupied, 36.5% renter occupied, and 10.2% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.77%. Median home value in the area is \$168,009, compared to a median home value of \$264,021 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.76% annually to \$202,082.
