The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 75.3 in the identified area, compared to 72.5 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current median household income is \$55,868 in the area, compared to \$79,068 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$65,320 in five years, compared to \$91,442 all U.S. households.

Current average household income is \$77,259 in this area, compared to \$113,185 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$91,829 in five years, compared to \$130,581 for all U.S. households.

Current per capita income is \$31,338 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$43,829. The per capita income is projected to be \$37,532 in five years, compared to \$51,203 for all U.S. households.

Currently, 42.4% of the 58,230 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 49.9%, renter occupied; and 7.7% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.9% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.1% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 57,222 housing units in the area and 7.5% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.41%. Median home value in the area is \$226,923, compared to a median home value of \$355,577 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 7.12% annually to \$320,097.
