A GATEWAY TO HOUSTON'S GREENBELT

M-K-T is named after the historic Missouri-Kansas-Texas (M-K-T) railroad line. This abandoned rail corridor has been transformed into the vibrant M-K-T Heights Hike and Bike Trail, which outlines the project's 3-acre linear park.

The M-K-T Heights Hike and Bike Trail connects into Houston's expansive 50-mile network of greenways and trails, linking the Heights to Downtown and nearby neighborhoods. Serving as the property's main artery, the trail seamlessly connects M-K-T to its top user demographic as well as daily neighborhood visitors.





THE NEIGHBORHOOD

The Heights is the unmistakable heart of Houston's urban renaissance. Located just five minutes west of Downtown and ten minutes east of The Galleria, the neighborhood is home to three historic districts, a thriving art scene, and a strong sense of community.
