In the identified area, the current year population is 267,537. In 2020, the Census count in the area was 261,688. The rate of change since 2020 was 0.52% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 270,104 representing a change of 0.19% annually from 2024 to 2029. Currently, the population is 48.9% male and 51.1% female.

Persons of Hispanic origin represent 19.4% of the population in the identified area compared to 19.6% of the U.S. population. Persons of Hispanic Origin may be of any race. The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 78.2 in the identified area, compared to 72.5 for the U.S. as a whole.

The five-year projection of households is 115,036, a change of 0.47% annually from the current year total. Average household size is currently 2.35, compared to 2.38 in the year 2020. The number of families in the current year is 62,996 in the specified area.

Current median household income is \$76,707 in the area, compared to \$79,068 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$93,717 in five years, compared to \$91,442 all U.S. households.

Current average household income is \$124,240 in this area, compared to \$113,185 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$144,686 in five years, compared to \$130,581 for all U.S. households.

Current per capita income is \$52,198 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$43,829. The per capita income is projected to be \$61,611 in five years, compared to \$51,203 for all U.S. households.

Currently, 47.2% of the 120,959 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 45.7%, renter occupied; and 7.1% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.9% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.1% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 116,485 housing units in the area and 6.7% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.89%. Median home value in the area is \$446,451, compared to a median home value of \$355,577 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.06% annually to \$518,954.

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
