

Parcel Overview





Georgia Cyber Center

The U.S. Army Cyber Command, stationed at Fort Gordon, manages and secures Army networks while conducting cyber operations against adversaries. With around 16,500 personnel globally, it relocated from Fort Meade in 2013, contributing significantly to Fort Gordon's transformation into a joint forces hub and bolstering Augusta's economy. Augusta's appeal to tech companies is further enhanced by the presence of the U.S. Cyber Command, the Georgia Cyber Center, a \$100 million facility representing a groundbreaking partnership among various sectors. This investment underscores the momentum of public/private collaborations in driving innovation and growth in cybersecurity.

Augusta National Golf Club

Every April, Augusta becomes a magnet for golf aficionados, attracting over 200,000 attendees and infusing the local economy with vitality. This fervor for golf radiates from Augusta National Golf Club, a prestigious institution operating as a for-profit corporation and shrouded in secrecy regarding its operations. Founded in 1932 by Bobby Jones and Clifford Roberts, the club hosts the revered Masters Tournament annually since 1934, distinguishing itself as a pinnacle of golfing excellence, as recognized by Golf Digest and Golfweek Magazine.

Fort Gordan

Fort Gordon, situated in Augusta, Georgia, has become a cornerstone of the local economy, catalyzing growth and employment opportunities. With the relocation of the U.S. Army Cyber Command in 2013, the installation has evolved into a hub for joint forces activities, training, and operations, significantly impacting east Georgia's economic landscape.
