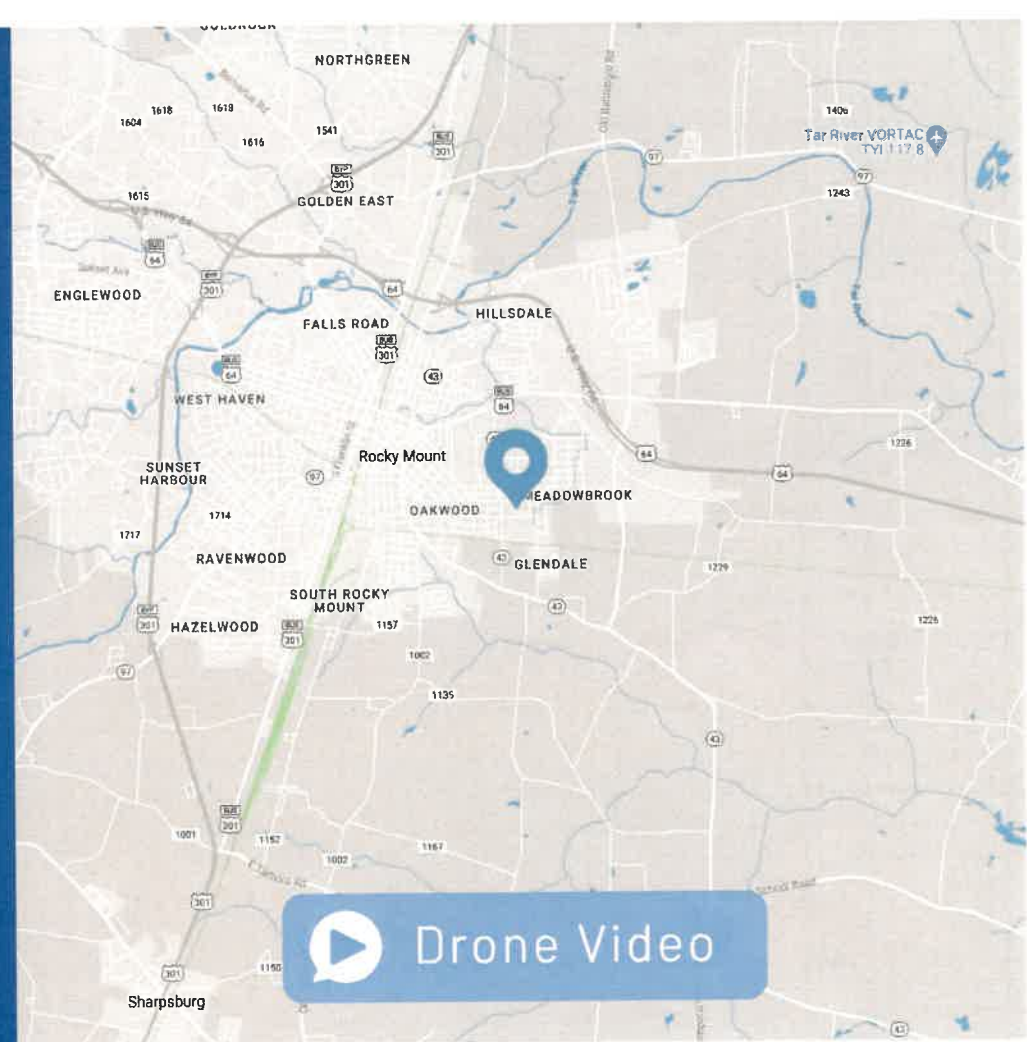

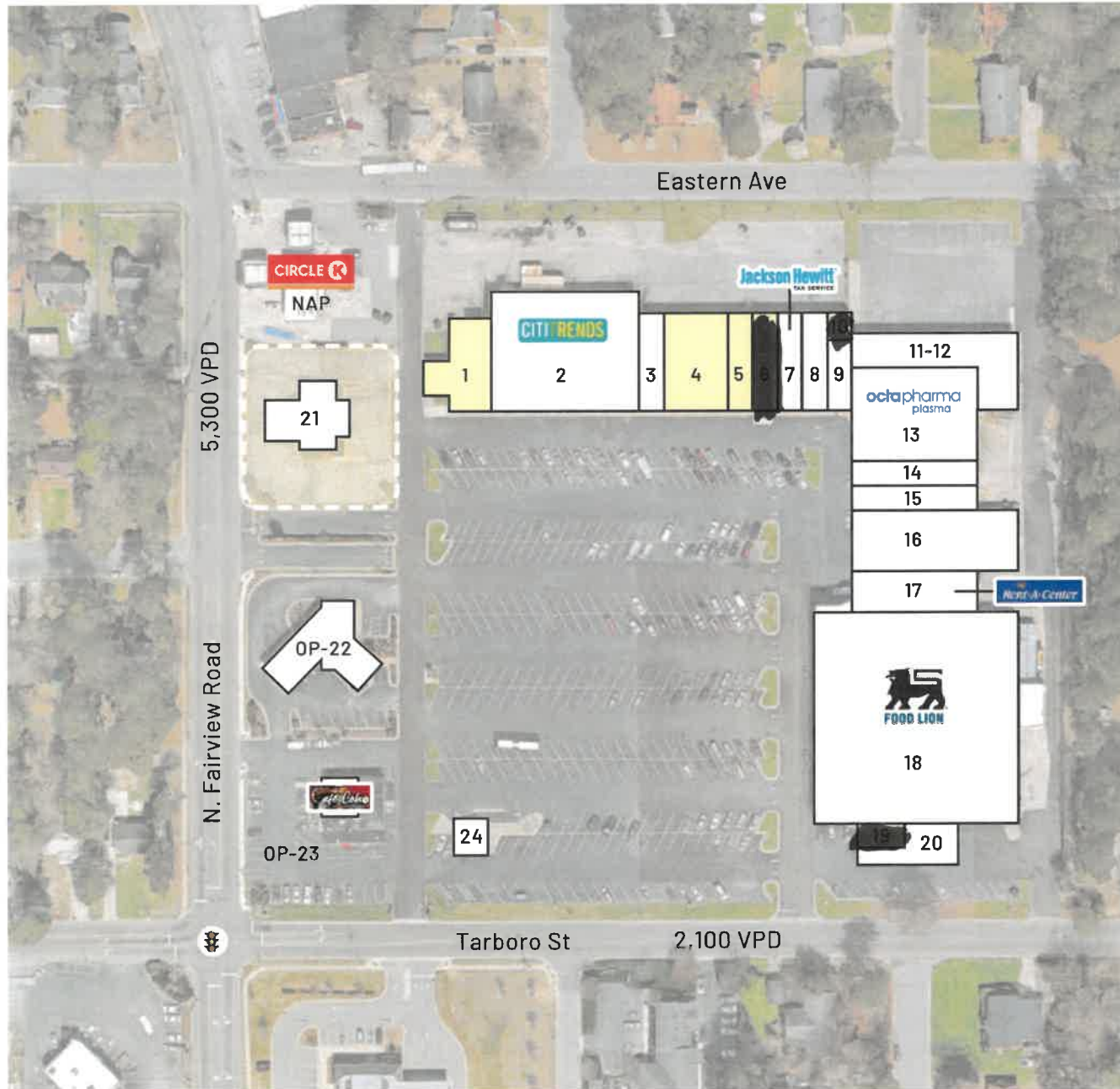

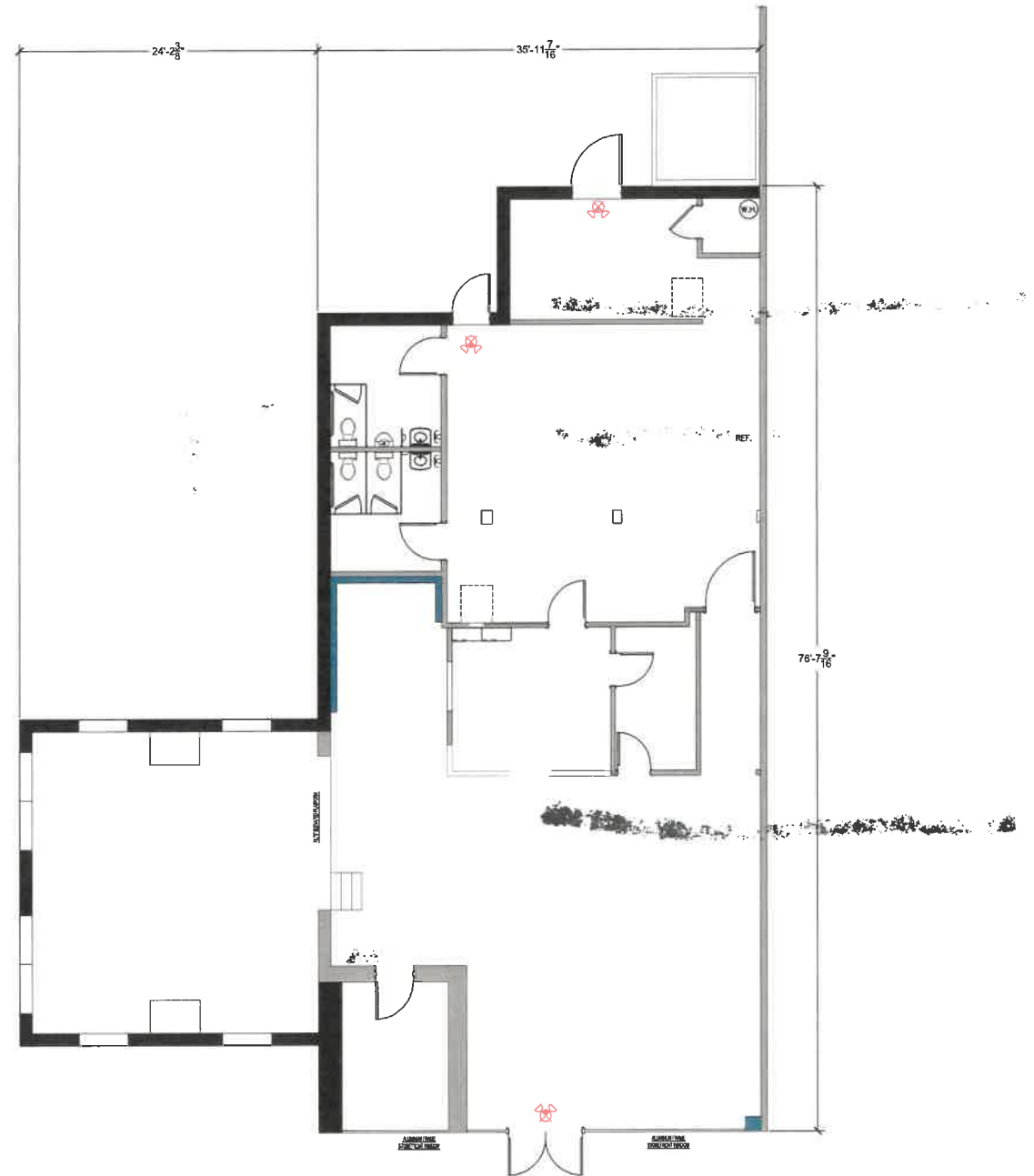
Site Plan

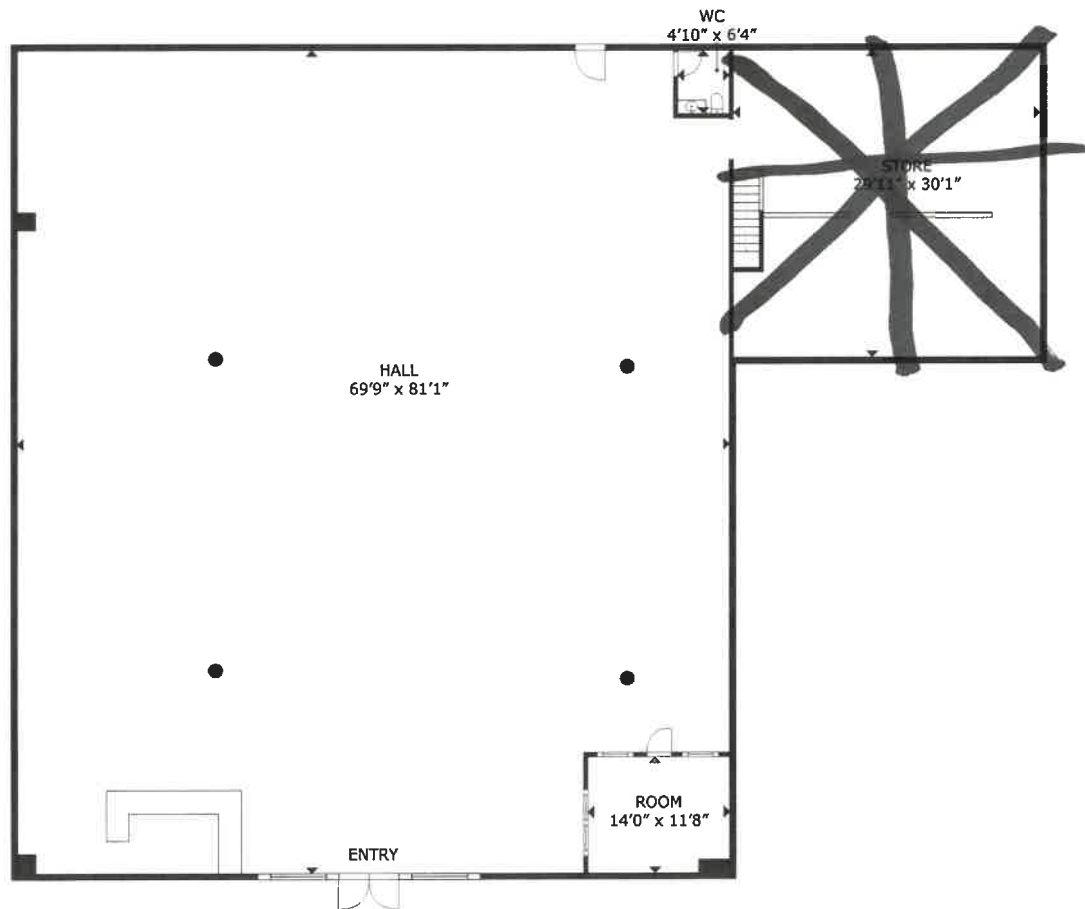

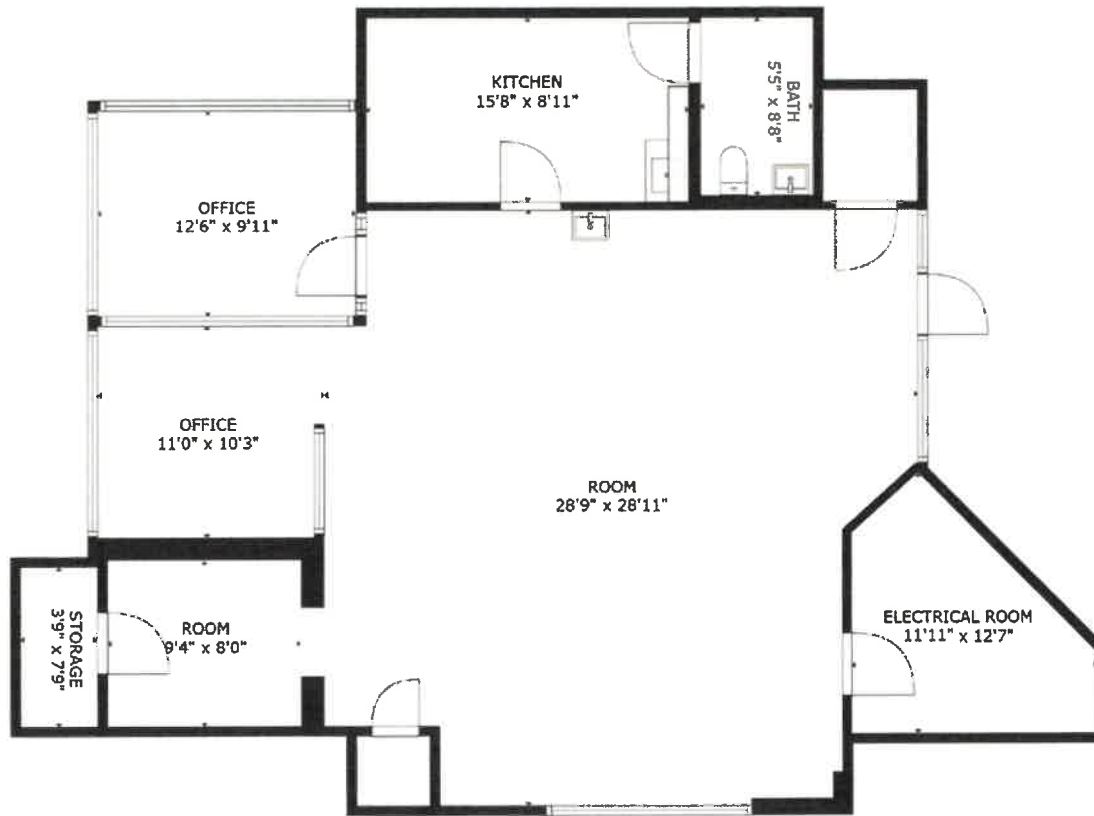

Rocky Mount North Carolina

The city of Rocky Mount lies between two counties, Edgecombe and Nash, in North Carolina. Rocky Mount's metropolitan area or "Twin Counties" is known for its deep historical roots. Known for its rail transport, farming, and textiles, the small town next to Tar River officially became a city in 1867.

Now, the area is well known for its diverse economy, from biomedical pharmaceuticals to manufacturing and logistics. The city was named the 6th "Best Small Places For Business And Careers" in 2018 by Forbes Magazine, and before that, it bagged the All-America City Award from the National Civic League twice; First in 1969 and then again in 1999. In more recent times, Rocky Mount NC has become known as the perfect pitstop city for those road tripping on the I-95.
