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



## **Neighborhood Highlights**


- Lake Grove exudes old-world charm, with a mix of distinctive homes on large rambling lots, established gardens, and quiet, meandering streets.

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## **DEMOGRAPHICS WITHIN ONE MILE OF SUBJECT PROPERTY**

The current year population is 9,471. The 2010 Census population count in the area was 7,905, and 9,208 in 2020, a 1.9% annual growth rate. The rate of growth since 2020 was 0.7% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 9,569 representing a 0.2% annual change. Currently the population is 49.9% male and 50.1% female. The median age in this area is 42.5, compared with the median age of 38.9. The household count in this area has changed from 3,737 in 2020 to 3,750 in the current year, a change of 0.13% annually. The five-year projection of households is 3,804, a change of 0.29% annually from the current year total. Average household size is currently 2.52, compared to 2.46 in the year 2020. The number of families in the current year is 2,435 in the specified area. Current median household income is \$131,006 in the area, compared to \$72,603 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$146,465 in five years, compared to \$82,410 for all U.S. households. Current per capita income is \$73,721 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$41,310. The per capita income is projected to \$83,760 in five years, compared to \$47,525 for all U.S. households. Currently 67.8% of the 3,937 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.2% renter occupied; and 4.8% are vacant. 64.6% of the housing units in the US are owner occupied, 35.4% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2010, there were 3,374 housing units in the area - 68.9% owner occupied, 26.5% renter occupied, and 4.6% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.1%.
