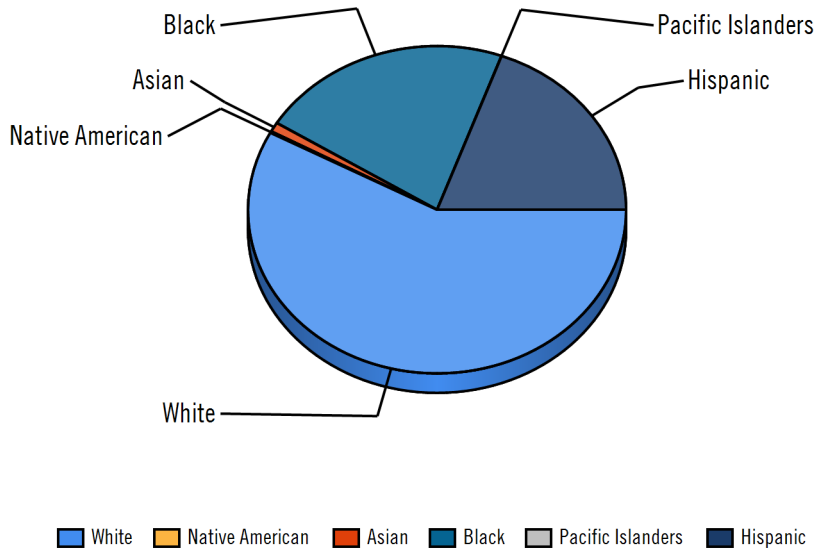

Population by Distance and Age (2020)



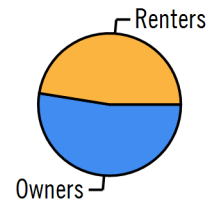
Ethnicity within 5 miles



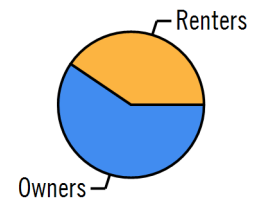
Home Ownership 1 Mile

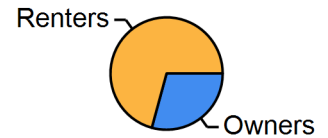
Population by Distance and Age (2020)



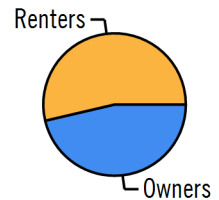

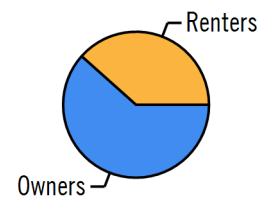
