With a ski season that typically extends into June and over 300 days of sunshine annually, visitors to Mammoth experience the best of both worlds. The region's high altitude and abundance of northern exposure ensure excellent snow preservation, resulting in one of the longest snow seasons in North America. This exceptional climate, coupled with Mammoth's annual influx of over 3 million visitors, positions The Village at Mammoth as one of the most visited mountain destination centers on the West Coast, making it an even more compelling investment opportunity for those looking to capitalize on the growth and popularity of premier ski destinations.

Since opening in 2003, The Village at Mammoth has been a year-round event destination featuring live music, festivals, and entertainment for locals and visitors alike. With diverse dining options, it is a culinary haven for casual or upscale experiences. The immediate area expanded to include the Westin Monache Resort in 2007, providing nightly rental condominiums. Guests enjoy heated pools, and access to Mammoth's finest dining and shopping. The Village is a central hub for summer activities, including weekly movies, concerts and community events. During the ski season, more festivals take place to celebrate the holidays and winter weather, while the gondola connects The Village to Canyon Lodge at Mammoth Mountain supporting daily traffic and visits to the Property. The Village provides an all-encompassing experience in Mammoth's high mountain paradise.

Mammoth Lakes hosts vibrant year-round events and recreation. Winter brings skiing and snowboarding at Mammoth Mountain, seamlessly transitioning into spring with hiking, golf, and fishing. 
Home to California's highest four-season resort, Mammoth Lakes boasts a summit at 11,053 feet above sea level and enjoys 300 days of annual sunshine. The Mammoth Mountain Ski Resort, the tallest ski resort in California, features 28 chairlifts and two gondolas, providing




access to nearly 3,500 acres of skiable terrain. With 150 distinct runs, ranging from easy learning terrain to challenging expert chutes, and an average annual snowfall of 400 inches, Mammoth offers a diverse experience for all winter enthusiasts.

Beyond winter activities, the town is surrounded by stunning national parks, forests, and wilderness areas. The Inyo National Forest, serving as the gateway to Mount Whitney, the highest mountain in the continental United States, is an integral part of the region. Additionally, Mammoth Lakes is conveniently located just 32 miles north of Yosemite National Park, California's most visited national park, which spans over 1200 square miles and offers world-class climbing, awe-inspiring waterfalls, and abundant camping opportunities.

## LIMEIGHT RESIDENCES & HOTEL

The Limelight Hotel development project consists of a 6-story condominium hotel with 151 condo hotel rooms, 15 managed residential condominium units, and understructure parking for 181 vehicles. Hotel amenities are oriented to guests of the hotel, and include a lobby, town hall dining area, convenience retail, meeting space, ski club lounge, fitness center, and an outdoor pool/jacuzzi terrace.







The Sawyer (Phase 1 of The Parcel) includes 81 apartment units within 2 buildings at several affordability levels and a variety of unit sizes between studio and 3 bedroom, as well as a childcare facility, community space, and public park.



## ROYAL PEAK DEVELOPMENT

Regal Peaks development project consists of a 5-story Resort Condominium development with a total of 198 rooms within 118 condominium units. Development consists of 4 levels of resort condominiums located above one level of understructure parking garage. The project includes 118 resort condominium units as well as a 2,200 square foot restaurant, Nordic spa and other amenities oriented to guests of the hotel.
