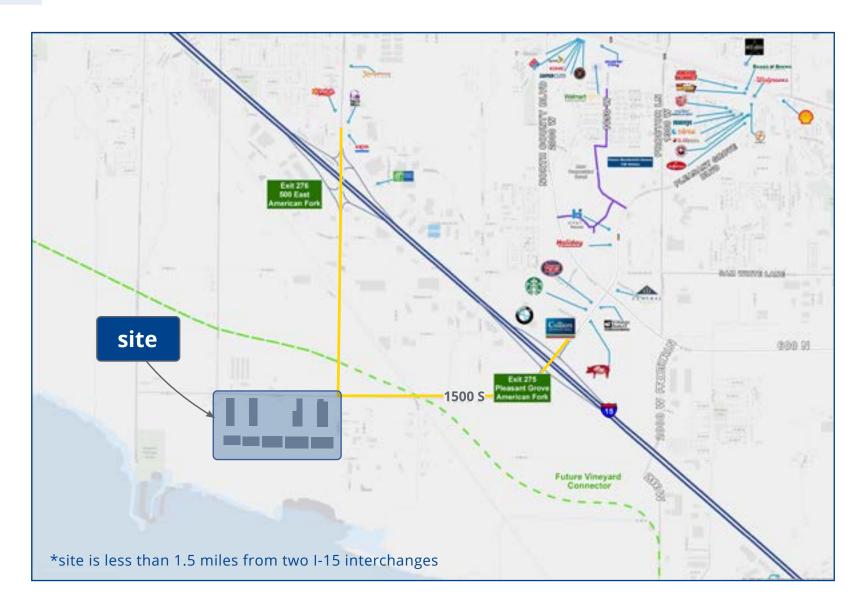

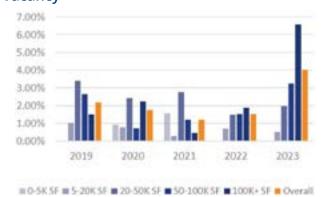
#### Ave. Asking Lease Rates
