




Location Overview





Pasco-Hernando State College

Pasco-Hernando State College is a public institution in New Port Richey, Florida. Its campus is located in a suburb with a total enrollment of 9,886. The school utilizes a semester-based academic year. The student-faculty ratio is 28-to-1. The highest degree offered at Pasco-Hernando State College is an associate degree. The school has an open admissions policy and offers credit for life experiences.

Students can earn degrees and certificates in 38 different fields. Popular programs include: Liberal Arts and Sciences/Liberal Studies, Registered Nursing/Registered Nurse, and Mental and Social Health Services and Allied Professions, Other.



Saint Leo University

Saint Leo University is a private, nonprofit liberal arts university located in Saint Leo, with additional education centers and online programs that serve students worldwide. Founded in 1889, it is one of the oldest Catholic universities in Florida and is affiliated with the Roman Catholic Church. The main campus is situated in Saint Leo, about 35 miles north of Tampa. Saint Leo University offers a wide range of undergraduate, graduate, and doctoral programs across various fields of study. These include business, education, criminal justice, psychology, computer science, liberal arts, nursing, and more.

Moffitt Cancer Center New 775-acre Campus

The Moffitt Cancer Center is set to begin construction on a massive 775-acre campus in Pasco County. When complete, the Moffitt Cancer Center's new Speros FL campus will employ 14,000 people working out of 140 buildings, 16 million square feet of lab, clinical, office and manufacturing space, and have six miles of new roads. Phase I of the development will include building several facilities totaling 650,000 square feet. Construction is expected to last until 2028. Moffitt Cancer Center is the only National Center Institute-designated Comprehensive Cancer Center based in Florida. It's home to Florida's largest clinical cancer research unit with more than 450 clinical trials and employs more than 6,500 people at an average salary of more than \$72,500. Moffitt Cancer Center has an economic impact of nearly \$2.4 billion in the state of Florida.



Bayonet Point Hospital

This 392-bed acute care hospital employs 350 physicians, 1,300 colleagues, and 500 volunteers on the healthcare delivery team. The hospital has the only Level II Trauma Center and Comprehensive Stroke Center in Florida's Pasco, Hernando, and Citrus counties. Healthgrades ranked the hospital as one of America's 50 best hospitals for orthopedic surgery award all in 2023. HCA Florida Bayonet Point has a nationally recognized Heart Institute, Accredited Stroke Center, Accredited Chest Pain Center, Commission on Cancer approved Cancer Care, Orthopedic and Neurosurgery program.



Morton Plant North Bay Hospital

Morton Plant North Bay Hospital was built in 1965, has 141 acute care beds and is West Pasco County's only not-for-profit community hospital. The hospital has been expanding to a modern community-based medical complex since 2010, and in 2016 underwent a 24.7 million renovation. The hospital's Comprehensive Breast Program is accredited by the National Accreditation Program for Breast Centers, the first hospital in Tampa Bay to achieve its award, and the American Heart Association and American Stroke Association recognizes Morton Plant Hospital for achieving the Get With the Guidelines - Stroke GOLD PLUS award.
