

RANCHO CUCAMONGA, CALIFORNIA

The City of Rancho Cucamonga was incorporated in 1977. The City encompasses approximately 40.2 square miles. It is located between the cities of Upland to the west, Ontario to the south, Fontana to the east and is in the western section of San Bernardino County which is in the southern part of the State of California. The City of Rancho Cucamonga had a population of 177,080 as of July 1, 2019.

The City is located within a regional area that is the jobs engine for California, and California is the jobs engine for the United States. The local economy includes a diverse business base of office, light manufacturing and distribution, and retail which emphasizes the City's efforts at attracting and retaining sales tax generating businesses to help provide a stable financial base. Etiwanda School District, Chaffey Community College, Inland Empire Health Plan, Mission Foods, Alta Loma School District, City of Rancho Cucamonga, Amphastar Pharmaceutical, Mercury Insurance Company, Macy's, Central School District, Bass Pro Shop, Coca Cola Bottling Co. and ADECCO are the Principal Employers.

Residents of Rancho Cucamonga have easy access to all of the entertainment offerings of Los Angeles. In addition, some of the more notable attractions in and around Rancho Cucamonga include The Casa de Rancho Cucamonga, The Rancho Cucamonga Grape Harvest Festival, Railroading in the Cajon Pass, Victoria Gardens Cultural Center, Wineries in and around Rancho Cucamonga.

Rancho Cucamonga is home to a Minor League Baseball (MiLB) team, the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes. The Quakes are a Class A Advanced Affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim.

The nearest major airport is LA/Ontario International Airport. Another major airport is John Wayne Airport. Bob Hope Airport has domestic flights from Burbank, CA. Long Beach Airport has domestic flights from Long Beach, CA. Los Angeles International Airport has international and domestic flights from Los Angeles, CA.

The San Bernardino County encompasses an area of over 20,160 square miles and includes 24 incorporated cities. In terms of land area, it is the largest county in the contiguous United States. The County is also one of the fastest growing areas in the nation and is the fifth most populous of the 58 counties in California.
