- 91' of frontage on I-Drive with three curb cuts
- Convenient access from I-4's Exit 75A to Universal Blvd and I-Drive; this portion of I-4 sees  $\pm$ 172,000 vehicles daily
- Located in the Orlando Crossings shopping center, anchored by Seabra Foods, Disney Gifts, Rum Jungle and Orlando's famous Air Force Fun Heli-Tours
- Surrounded by Orlando's main attractions, from theme parks like Universal Studios Florida (Universal Epic Universe, Islands of Adventure, Volcano Bay), SeaWorld Orlando (Aquatica, Discovery Cove), ICON Park and Fun Spot America to the Orange County Convention Center and many premium shopping and creative dining experiences
- Walking and Driving Distances: One-minute walk from Fun Spot America across the street, 0.8 miles from Dezerland Park, 1.2 miles from Universal Epic Universe, 1.6 miles from Universal Florida and 2.1 miles from ICON Park



## ATTRACTIONS

The District allures vacationers from near and far seeking experiences to remember. The largest attractions are Universal Studios Florida (Epic Universe, Islands of Adventure, Volcano Bay), Fun Spot America, ICON Park (The Orlando Eye, SEA Life Aquarium, Madame Tussauds, Ripley's), Sea World (Aquatica, Discovery Cove) and Dezerland Park with many more.



## Accommodations

The District is the place to stay in Orlando's tourism corridor; there are **55,900+ rooms in total**. Notable accommodations are the Hyatt Regency Orlando (1,604 rooms), Rosen Shingle Creek (1,501 rooms), the Universal Stella Nova & Terra Luna Resorts (1,500 rooms), the Rosen Centre Hotel (1,334 rooms), and Orlando World Center Marriott (2,010 rooms) - the world's largest Marriott.



## Shopping

Unparalleled shopping awaits - take a walk along I-Drive and be wowed by the retailers that await. Among the largest retail destinations include Universal CityWalk (Universal Studios Store, Rock Shop), Orlando Intl Premium Outlets (Saks OFF 5TH, Coach, Nike Factory Store) and Orlando Vineland Premium Outlets (Armani, BOSS, Under Armour).

## RECREATION

Day and night, the District lights the Orlando skyline with the most extensive recreational activities alongside its main attractions. Recreational spaces include Universal CityWalk, The Pointe's WonderWorks / Live! / Funny Bone Comedy Club, Titanic: The Artifact Exhibition, Air Force Fun Helicopter Tours, Andretti Karting, Topgolf Orlando, Dave & Buster's and soon ICON Park's Blue Man Group theatre.



## Connections

Form connections and learn at Orlando's premier Orange County Convention Center. Spanning 7M sq. ft. of space, the complex attracts approximately 1.5M individuals annually. The largest conventions hosted in 2025 were the AAU Jr. National Volleyball Championships (300K attendees), Megacon Orlando (160K attendees) and the Open Championship Series (70K attendees).
