The influences of Frank Lloyd Wright on the design, in 1963, of the Harold Nathan Ives dental office by noted San Francisco architect and Wright associate Aaron G. Green. Dr. Ives practiced dentistry in Cloverdale from 1952 to 1973 and there may be some old time townspeople who will remember him. You will hear how the spirit of Frank Lloyd Wright directed Dr. Ives to his protégé, Aaron Green, to design his private residence and dental office, both in Cloverdale.
