At 20 E. 



Three Rivers Heritage Trail

A local staple for outdoor enthusiasts in North Side and Downtown.

Spanning the edge of the North Shore neighborhood along the Allegheny River, this paved riverside trail draws hundreds of daily walkers, joggers, bikers, and dog walkers with its scenic riverfront and cityscape views, interactive green spaces, art installations, and lush lawns.

Allegheny Landing, a parklet connected to the trail, is just three blocks from 20 E. General Robinson Street.



North Shore Drive

A fan-favorite street peppered with bars, eateries, and arcades.

Stretching between the Rivers Casino and PNC Park, this throughway is peppered with entertainment: wildly popular bars such as Tequila Cowboy, The Foundry, Jason Aldean's, and Shorty's Pints x Pints line the street, which also houses multiple retailers, a hotel, and apartments.

The entry to North Shore Drive is just a 5-minute walk from 20 E. General Robinson Street.


