

GROUND FLOOR SITE PLAN






PROJECT OVERVIEW



Transit Oriented Development in the heart of the Village of Pelham

- Hudson is developing a new 127-unit rental building in the Village of Pelham's downtown corridor. Pelham House will strengthen the Village's vibrant commercial district by transforming an underutilized site into a mixed-use, transit-oriented development.
- The design of the building was thoughtfully crafted to complement Pelham's architectural character, while also providing first-class apartments and amenities. Residents will have access to business. centers, a fitness room, a ground-floor courtyard, a rooftop lounge and terrace, and parking. The development will also add 60 municipal parking spaces and three new retail spaces to the Village's downtown. As part of the same project, Hudson and its partners completed construction on a muchneeded, state-of-the-art Municipal Center across the street from Pelham House to house the Village's Fire Department, Police Department, and Administrative Offices. The Municipal Center is designed to be a new welcome center for the Village's evolving downtown and a celebration of civic life.
