





AERIAL 298-302 LINCOLN ROAD

PROPOSED RENDERINGS

Lincoln Road spans the heart of Miami Beach with overall traffic approximately 11 Million annual visitors and over 12.6 Million hotel stays annually in the region.

With over 800,000 SF of retail, the mix on Lincoln Road counts major national brands including Nike's only flagship store in Florida; the largest H&M and Zara stores in the Southeast US, located in tastefully repurposed historical buildings; and one of the busiest Apple stores, alongside many others.

Considered a hub for arts, architecture, and culture, some of Miami's most popular performance venues are located in the Lincoln Road District, including New World Symphony, the Fillmore Miami Beach at the Jackie Gleason Theatre, The Colony Theatre (originally home to Paramount Pictures), The Miami Beach Urban Studios (MBUS), 1111 Lincoln Road, Oolite Arts, and Regal South Beach cinema complex.

Over 1 Million SF of office space also lines the road, providing a steady stream of professionals at lunch hour and after work.
