


# 167 Powell · Features ···

- 10,000+ hotel rooms adjacent to and within walking distance from the property











### The Numbers



SCAN FOR STATISTICS

- San Francisco had more than 23 million visitors in 2024 spending \$9.3 billion
- Visitors spending surpassed 2019's marks in 2024, while global visitor count is expected to fully recover
- In 2024, San Francisco welcomed 2.3 million international visitors, driven largely by European travelers
- International visitors comprised 24% of overnight visitors volume but over 60% of all overnight visitor spending in 2024, spending \$3.7 billion, up from \$1 billion in 2021
- Convention room nights on the books for 2025 are up 70% year over year with 670,000 confirmed room nights and 25,678 tentative room nights
- 10,000+ hotel rooms in walking distance


