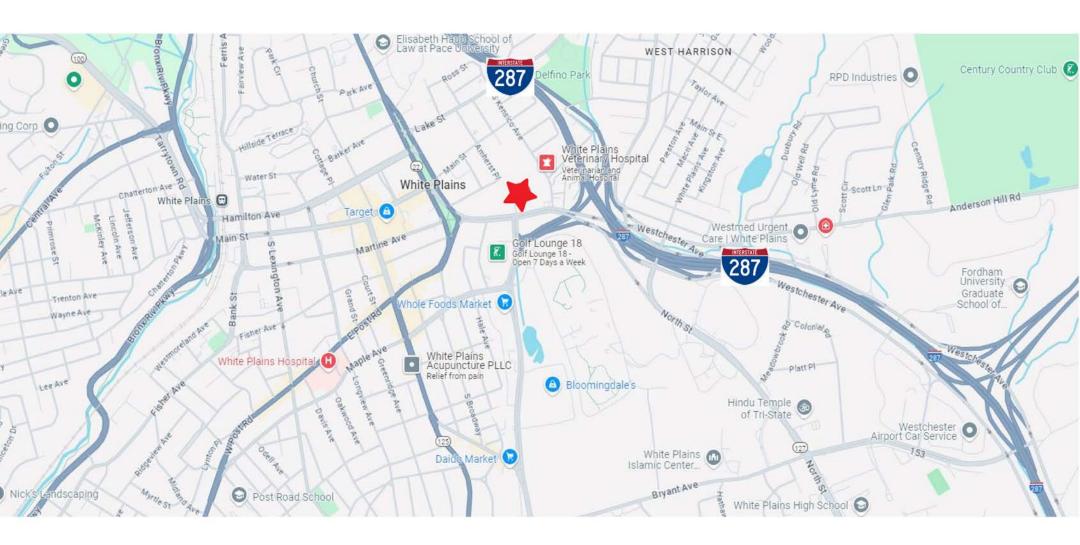


AERIAL MAP





REGIONAL MAP



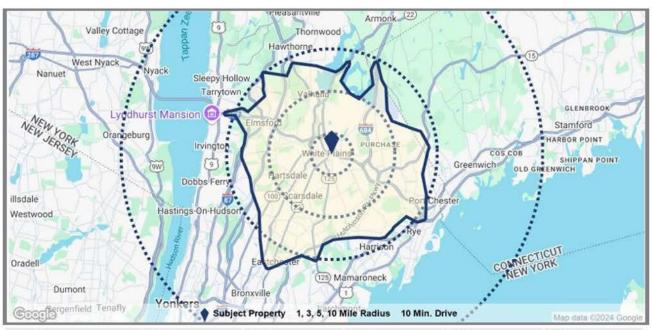


RETAIL MAP

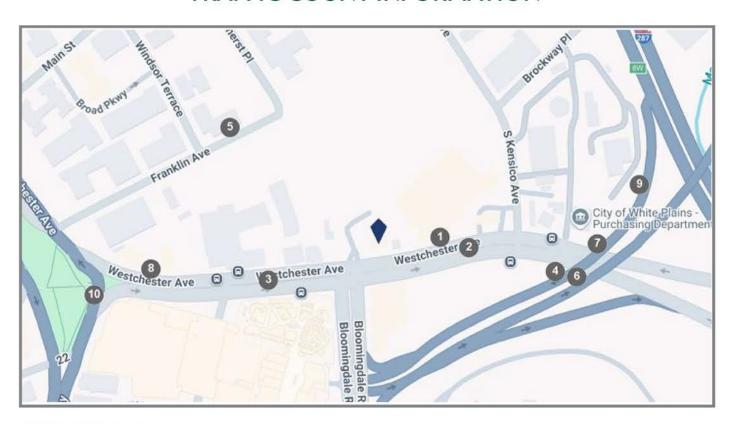
