Currently, 53.0% of the 58,371 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 39.4%, renter occupied; and 7.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.4% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 56,386 housing units in the area - 56.0% owner occupied, 36.6% renter occupied, and 7.4% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.55%. Median home value in the area is \$213,330, compared to a median home value of \$234,154 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.60% annually to \$230,895.
