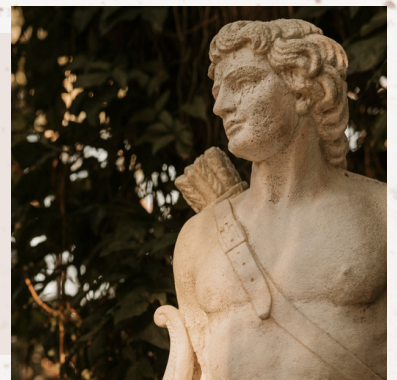


THE SONG TREE
