#### **SITE & MARKET OVERVIEW**

Industrial complex consisting of over 150,000 SF of heavy manufacturing space on just under 9 acres available for sale, ideal for manufacturing, heavy industrial, or redevelopment/adaptive reuse. The site is conveniently located just one-mile from the Route 30 and Interstate-83 interchange, while also situated on the fringe of the York City Central Business District just behind WellSpan Park, home of the York Revolution Baseball team.

The property features ample on-site parking, lay-down yard, and convenient access via Arch Street and Queen Street gated entrances. There is an active Norfolk Southern rail line adjacent to the site, but the rail sidings have been abandoned and require refurbishment. The buildings feature multiple bridge and jib cranes that range from 3-tons up to 40-tons, as well as clear heights ranging from 10' to 42'. Monitor roof systems provide ample natural light to the main industrial bays, with interior docks and drive-in doors throughout the complex.

The property is located in a Federal Opportunity Zone as well as a Foreign Trade Zone, and straddles two municipalities, York City and Spring Garden Township.




