Prime Village Location with Long-Term Upside – Located on a prominent **0.29-acre** corner lot just off Main Street, this fully leased mixed-use compound offers an ideal balance of diversification, visibility, and accessibility. The site sits at the southern extension of Sag Harbor's Village Core Business District, in an area poised for long-term growth and rising tenant demand.

Multi-Structure Layout with Private Parking – The property includes **3,000sf** of built space across three structures: a main two-story building and two freestanding cottages, all connected by a landscaped courtyard and supported by a private parking lot. Current tenant mix generates strong in-place income with upside through future repositioning.

Future Infrastructure & Neighboring Development – The site is positioned to benefit from future connection to Sag Harbor's sewer district, unlocking expanded use potential and improving long-term site functionality. Additionally, the adjacent luxury condo proposed development—with over two dozen new units—will bring new customers, value, and vitality to the immediate area.

Flexible Zoning & Conversion Potential – The property's zoning allows for a wide range of uses including office, personal service, retail, workshop, residential, and food service (via Special Exception). The main structure could be converted into a quick-service restaurant with 16 indoor seats and use of the outdoor patio, or the site can be reimagined with a unified site plan or optimized as-is.





SAG HARBOR

Sag Harbor is a village located within the Township of East Hampton located just 90 miles east of Manhattan. The area was settled in 1693 and was later incorporated as a village in 1846. The deep-water port to Gardiner's Bay made Sag Harbor a flourishing trading and port town. Now, the estates, waterfronts, restaurants, shops, and proximity to New York City that Sag Harbor has attracts international appeal.

As of 2024, Sag Harbor has a population of 2,796, with an average household income of \$214,384. Sag Harbor is currently growing at a rate of 0.39% annually, and its population has increased by 1.6% since the previous census in 2020.

Explore the Sag Harbor Whaling & Historical Museum to dive into the village's maritime past or catch a live show at Bay Street Theater. Outdoor enthusiasts can unwind at Havens Beach, walk along the Long Wharf Marina, or enjoy a picnic at Mashashimuet Park.

Main Street is known for its vibrant dining scene and small business shopping experience. Visitors can enjoy a diverse range of restaurants, from casual cafes to upscale eateries, many offering fresh seafood and farm-to-table options. The street is also home to unique boutiques, art galleries, and locally-owned shops,
