The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 69.5 in the identified area, compared to 64.0 for the U.S. as a whole.

Currently, 54.8% of the 95,719 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 36.3%, renter occupied; and 8.8% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 92,287 housing units in the area - 58.1% owner occupied, 33.6% renter occupied, and 8.3% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.64%. Median home value in the area is \$217,374, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 0.33% annually to \$220,975.
