You <u>may</u> qualify for one or both refunds from the State of Minnesota based on your 2024 Property Taxes. If you owned and occupied this property as your homestead on January 2, 2024, you may qualify for one or both of the following homestead credit refunds:

<u>Property Tax Refund</u> - If your taxes exceed certain income-based thresholds, and your total household income is less than \$135,410.
 <u>Special Property Tax Refund</u> - If you also owned and occupied this property as your homestead on January 2, 2023 and both of the following are true:

• The net property tax on your homestead increased by more than 12% from 2023 to 2024.

Penalty for Late Payment of Property Tax

If you pay your first half or second half property tax after the due dates, a penalty will be added to your tax. The later you pay, the greater the penalty you must pay. The table below shows the penalty amounts added to your tax if your property taxes are not paid before the date shown.

Personal Property Located on Leased

Government-owned Land: Taxes may be paid in two installments due at the same time as real property taxes. These taxes are subject to the same penalty schedule and penalty rates as real property taxes. All other personal property taxes are due in full on or before May 17, 2024.

Note to manufactured homeowners: The title to your manufactured home cannot be transferred unless all current year and delinquent personal property taxes are paid at the time of transfer.

Property Tax information: If you are blind, disabled or paraplegic, you may be entitled to receive a special tax classification for the home you live in. For more information about this special tax classification contact the county Assessor's office.

Senior Citizens'

The Senior Citizens' Property Tax Deferral Program provides a <u>low-interest loan</u> to senior citizens having difficulty paying property taxes. This is not a tax forgiveness program, however, this program:

• Limits the maximum amount of property tax paid to 3% of total household income, and

• Ensures the amount of tax paid remains the same as long as you participate in this program. To be eligible, you must file an application by November 1, 2024, as well as:

Property Tax

2. Have a household income of \$96,000 or less, and

1. Be at least 65 years old,

Deferral

3. Have lived in your home for at least 5 years.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR PROPERTY TAX STATEMENT: One statement per parcel is mailed per year. If you have not received your tax statement by April 1st of any year (July 15th for manufactured homes), please call (763) 323-5400 to request a duplicate. If you are no longer escrowing your taxes, you are responsible for paying the taxes due. Late tax payments will accrue penalty and interest regardless of who received the original statement.
