Currently, 40.0% of the 64,478 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 48.5%, renter occupied; and 11.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.7% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 60,206 housing units in the area - 43.5% owner occupied, 47.0% renter occupied, and 9.5% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 3.09%. Median home value in the area is \$178,435, compared to a median home value of \$200,006 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.80% annually to \$204,903.
