
Is a shopping mall located in Tarentum, Pennsylvania, about 20 miles northeast of downtown Pittsburgh. Opened in 2005, it was once the largest shopping complex in Western Pennsylvania, spanning approximately 1.1 million square feet. It featured a mix of retail stores, dining options, and entertainment venues, including a movie theater and an indoor racetrack.
