



LOCATION OVERVIEW

PHILADELPHIA

Philadelphia, the largest citv Pennsylvania, is located in the southeastern portion of the state at the junction of the Schuylkill and Delaware Rivers. It is located along the northeastern corridor, situated between Washington, D.C., and New York City. Philadelphia is a two hour drive from New York City and Baltimore, one hour from Atlantic City, and three hours from Washington, D.C. It is also conveniently along Amtrak's Northeastern located Corridor line, providing train service to New York within an hour and a half and to Washington, D.C. within two hours.




