- Master-planned and developed by Nationwide Realty Investors, Jerome Village consists of 2,000 acres in Union County, spanning 3 miles from north to south.
- Union County is one of the fastest-growing housing markets in the country, ranked 2nd in the state and 13th in the nation.
- In recent years, Union County's number of housing units has jumped nearly 4% each year. Jerome Village is in the heart of that growth.






Jerome Village - Facts and Figures



- Zoned for 4,000 residential units within its 2,000 acres.
- Sewer district encompasses 4,300 acres.
- 2,200 occupied homes with another 500 currently under construction.
- 3,300 home sites are either occupied or in contract with builder.
- Between 2023 and 2024 Jerome Village added 340 rental units and another 400 lots closed.
- Jerome Village accounts for nearly 3% of all permits pulled for housing developments across central Ohio.
- Average home price is \$590,000.
- The 2024 average household income in the 3-mile area of Jerome Village is \$281,338 and projected household income in 2026 is \$293,298.
- The population of Jerome Village is similar to that of Dublin City Schools, with 86% of households being family households and an average household size of 3.

The new Kroger Marketplace at Jerome Village is getting some neighbors.

With the grocery set to open next week at 12116 Sycamore Trace in Union County, Nationwide Realty Investors announced some of the tenants that will join the store as part of the new Jerome Village Market center.

Jerome Village is a 1,900-acre, multi-community development near Plain City and Glacier Ridge Metro Park. NRI is the project's lead developer.

The 123,000-square-foot Kroger store is one of the largest Kroger stores in the Midwest. That building also has an adjoining 20,000 square feet of retail.

"This is a really strong growth corridor in Central Ohio," NRI President Brian Ellis said in a press release. "In addition to supporting a lot of new jobs and economic activity, this retail center will serve as a hub of activity in Jerome Village and a draw well beyond the community's borders. It's all coming together: the jobs, the homes and the retail services, making this an even more desirable place to live and work."

Kroger opens first new Central Ohio Store

Grocery chain Kroger opens first new Central Ohio store in 15 years in Jerome Township near Plain City

Chris and Larry Murlin moved to Jerome Township about six years ago from Dayton. They have had to drive about 10-15 minutes, depending on traffic, to get to the nearest grocery store. But with the opening of a new Kroger off U.S. Route 42, they are now just a 3-minute drive away.

Hundreds of people lined up in the early morning on a crisp fall morning outside the first new Kroger in central Ohio in 15 years. Some local students added to the fanfare: The marching band from Fairbanks High School and cheerleaders from Jerome High School in Dublin City Schools welcomed some of the first shoppers.

Why Kroger opened a new store in Jerome Township

A nearby grocery store was long awaited by new residents of the Jerome Village development, one of the largest developed communities in central Ohio.

"There are so many people this is going to affect. ... Some people have had to drive miles to get to a store like this; now they can just hop on (U.S. Route) 42," Union County Commissioner Dave Lawrence said. "I'm so glad Kroger decided to locate a store here."
