

NORTHEAST TULSA COUNTY/AIRPORT CORRIDOR

This general area has been the most active Tulsa metro industrial corridor for a few reasons:

- 1) Significant transportation infrastructure providing high quality ingress/egress from area.
- 2) Significant electrical and natural gas capacity at competitive rates.
- 3) Large blocks/tracts of land are more readily available than in other areas of the county.
- 4) Proximity to a thriving suburb for housing, convenience goods and services and high quality of life for employees with relatively low cost of living.
- 5) High quality available labor force supported by state of the art industry training assistance through Tulsa Technology Center; north County location allows for easier workforce recruitment from farming communities to the north and east.
- 6) The various jurisdictions involved are user-friendly and understand the importance of customer deadlines.

Subject Site - Greenhill Distribution Center - Phase II

- 1) At the intersection of U.S. Highway 169 and State Highway 266 (46th Street North). Oklahoma Department of Transportation recently rebuilt this Highway interchange to allow for significant increase in capacity.
- 2) Near airport and Tulsa's Port of Catoosa inland waterway port.
- 3) No jurisdictional waterways on the subject site and no wetlands on the subject site.
- 4) Water and sanitary sewer to the site with sufficient capacity.
- 5) Capacity to do storm water retention offsite.
- 6) Subject site is currently zoned for "Industrial Medium" and Industrial Heavy" users.
- 7) In summary, the site is shovel ready for development in accordance with specific user requirements.
- 8) Landowner has development capacity to perform any "Seller-Required" work in a timely and professional manner.
