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LOCATION MAPS



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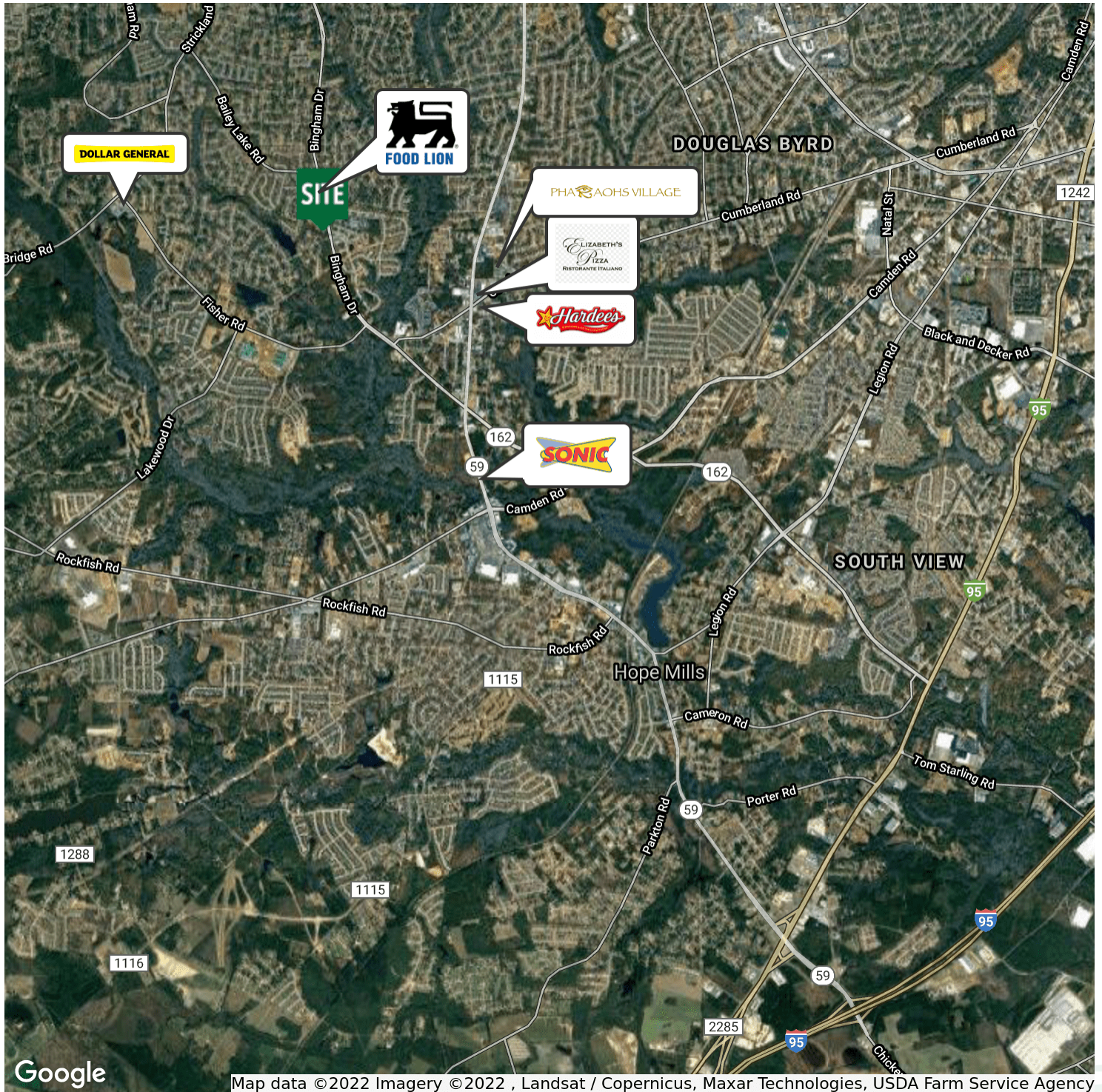

Currently, 44.7% of the 67,464 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 44.6%, renter occupied; and 10.7% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.3% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.2% are renter occupied; and 11.5% are vacant. In 2010, there were 63,191 housing units in the area - 52.5% owner occupied, 39.3% renter occupied, and 8.1% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.95%. Median home value in the area is \$145,666, compared to a median home value of \$264,021 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 6.65% annually to \$200,965.
