

SPRINGFIELD, TENNESSEE



Springfield is the county seat of Robertson County, TN, a rapidly growing region known for its agriculture, diverse economic activity, and strategic location. Positioned between Nashville and Clarksville, the county benefits from easy access to two of Tennessee's major economic hubs, offering excellent connectivity for businesses and residents alike. Robertson County is ranked 8th in the State of Tennessee (out of 95 total counties) for median income (\$74,440) and 10th in state for overall household wealth.

Springfield is a thriving industrial hub with a strong and diverse economy, driven by several major employers that anchor the region's workforce. Electrolux, a global leader in home appliances, operates a significant manufacturing facility in Springfield, employing a large portion of the local population. Another key player is Unarco, a prominent manufacturer of material handling systems, which has been a staple of Springfield's industrial landscape for years. The region is also home to NorthCrest Medical Center, a major healthcare provider that adds to the diversity of Springfield's economic base.
