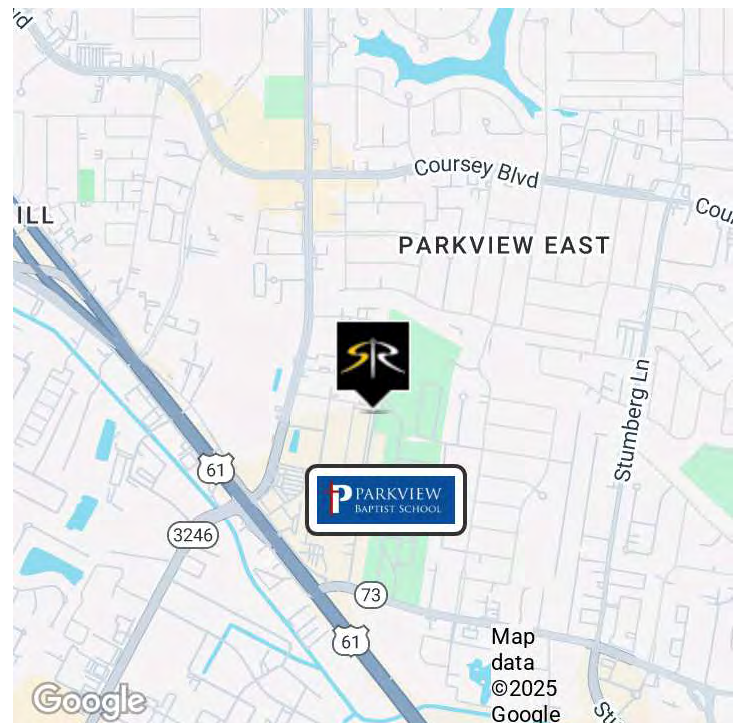

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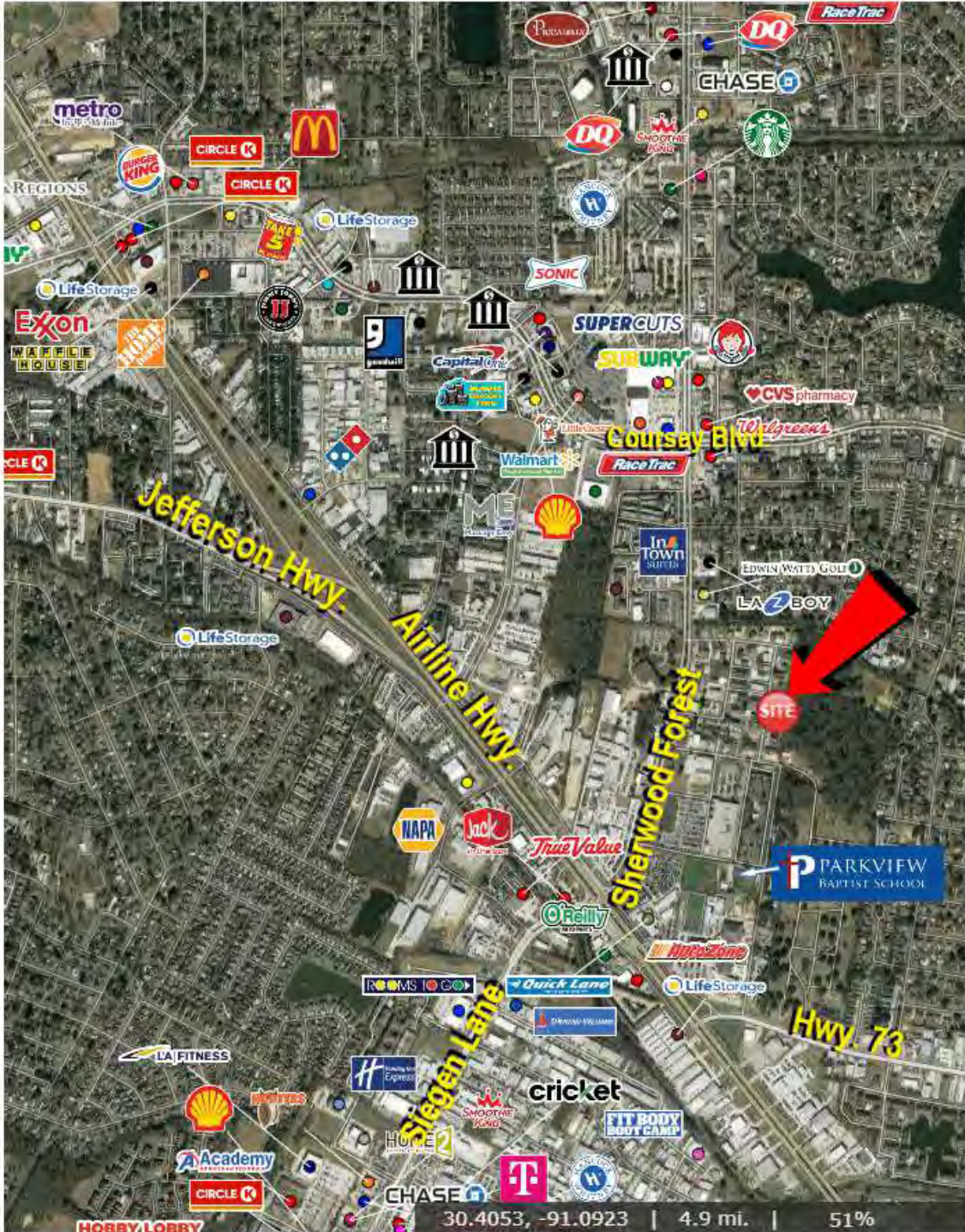
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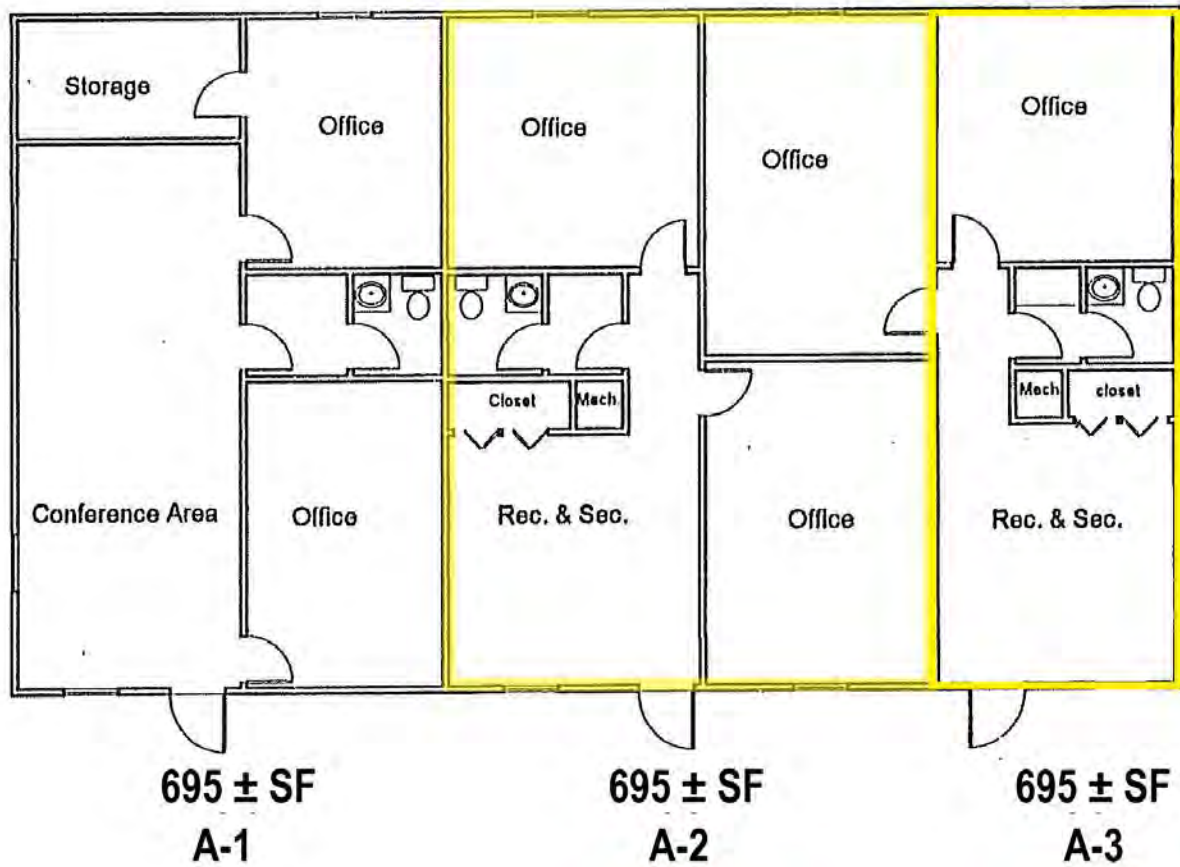
FLOOR PLAN: BUILDING A

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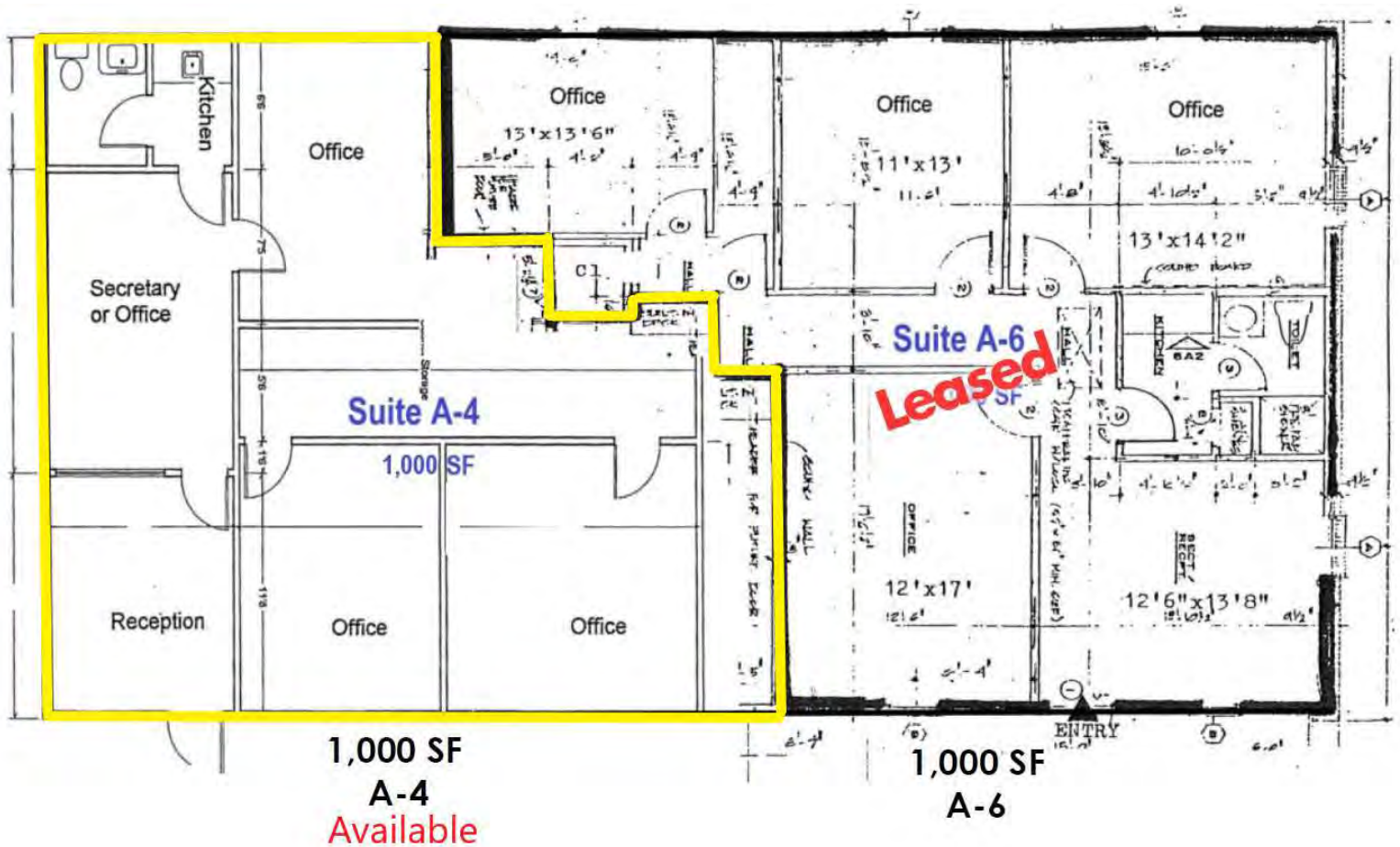

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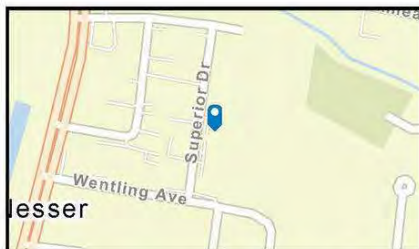
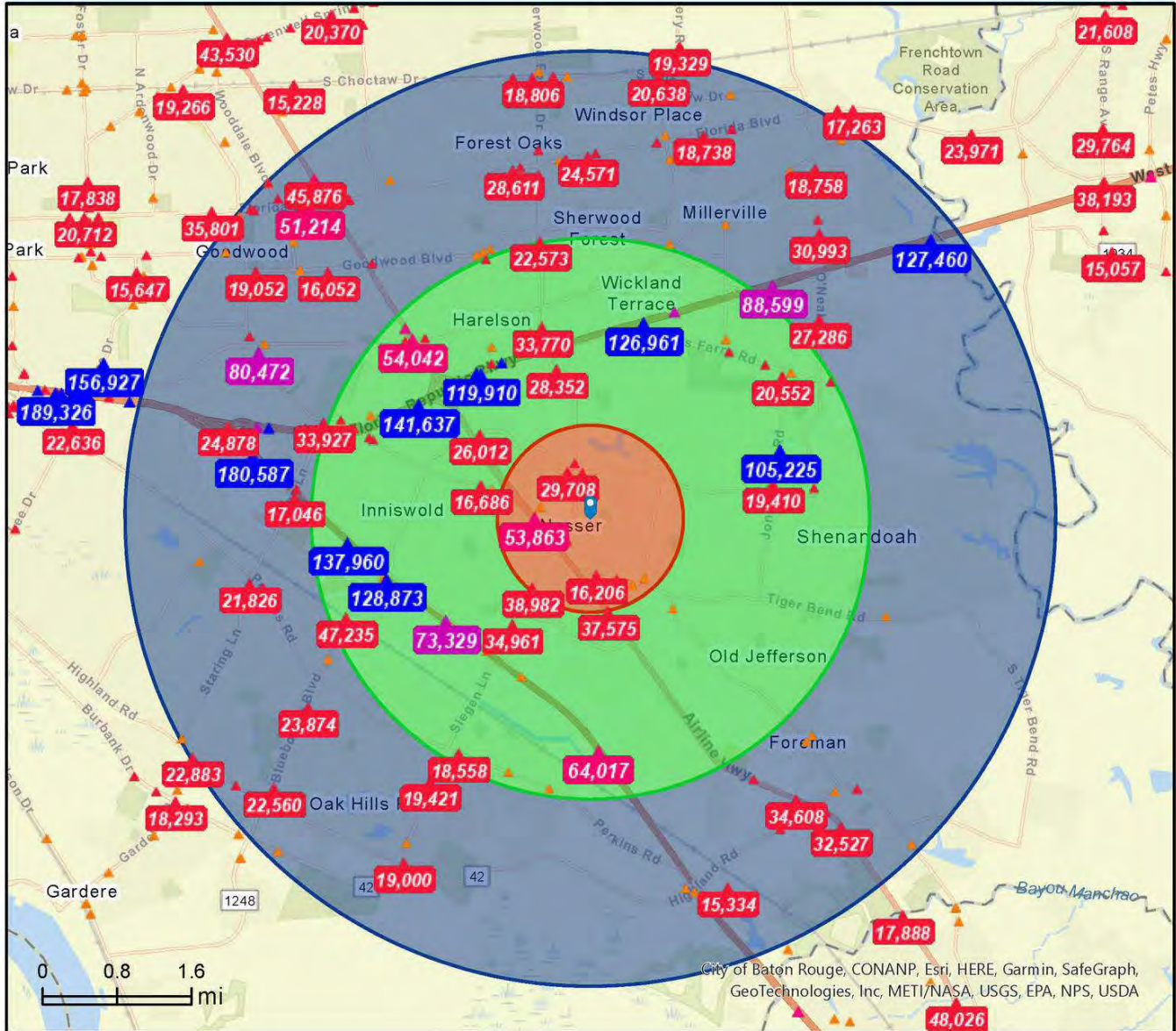
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TRAFFIC COUNT MAP

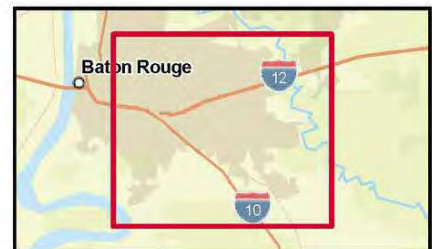

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DRIVE TIME MAP

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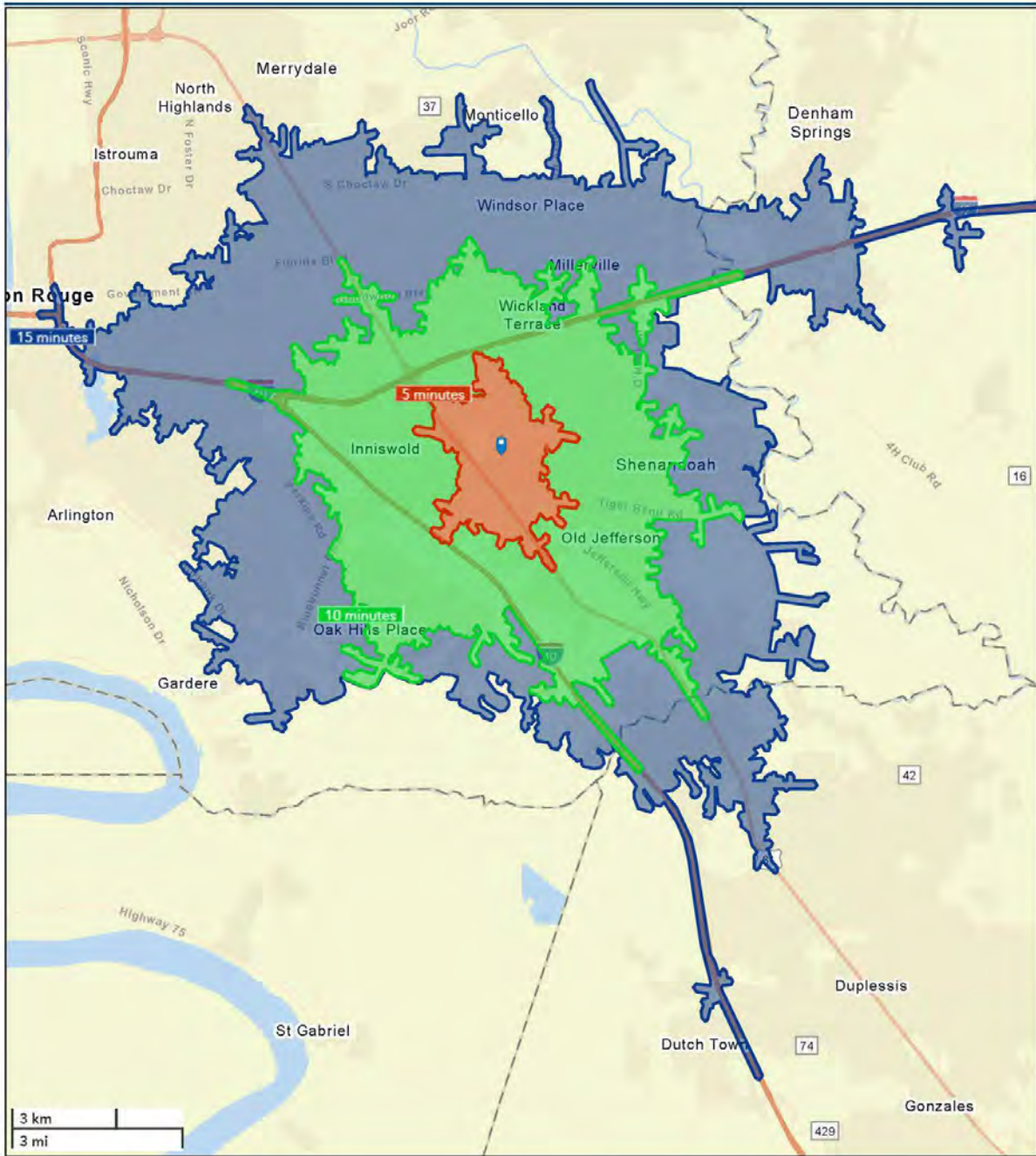

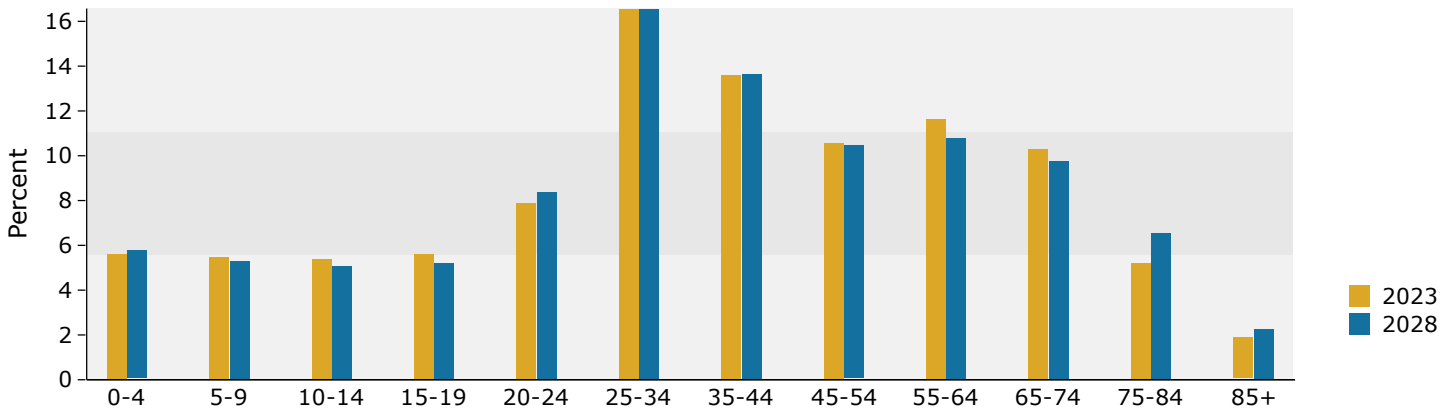

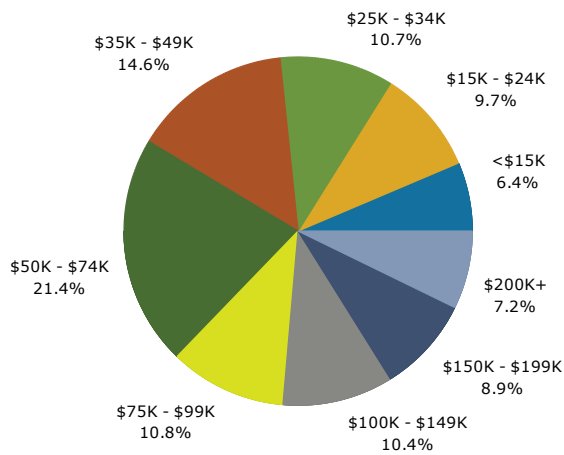

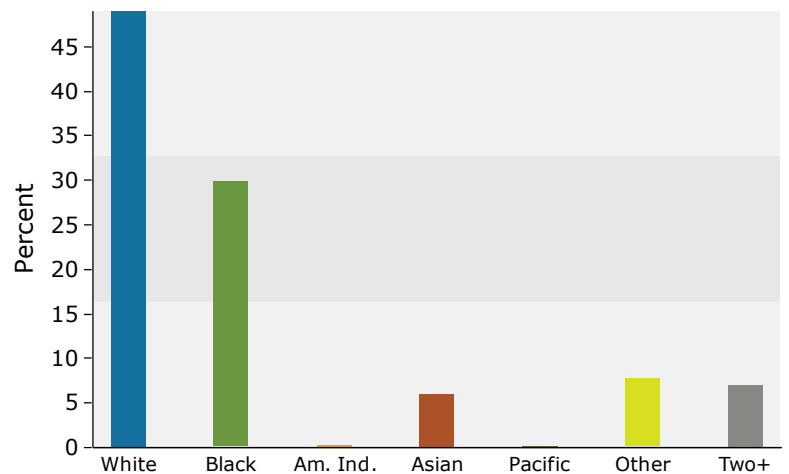
Population by Age

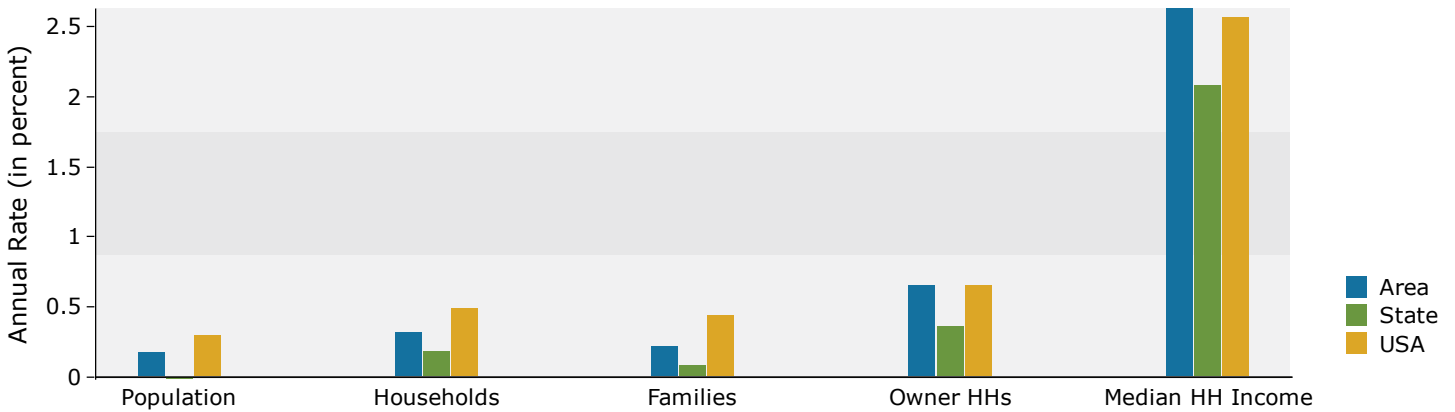

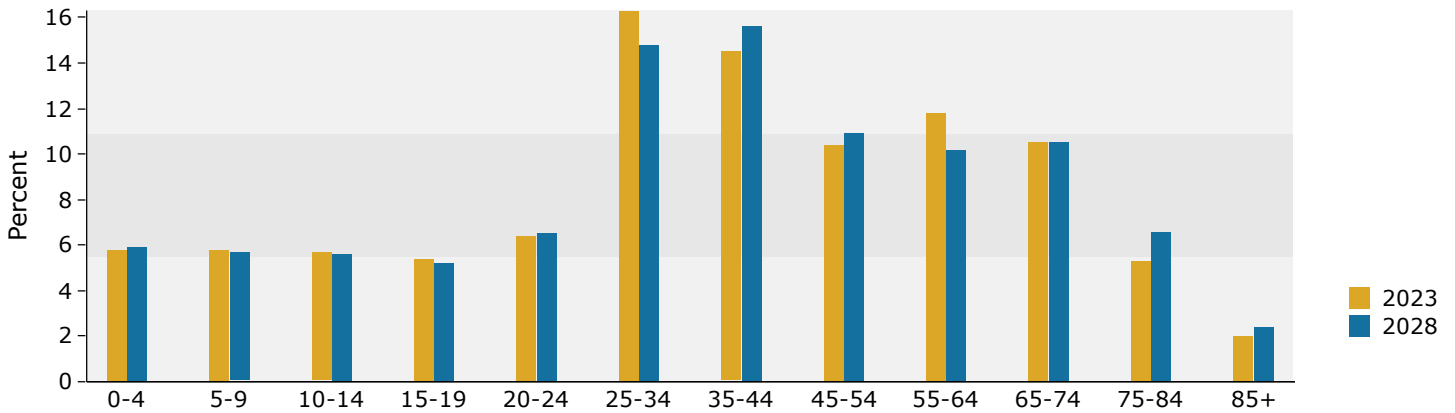

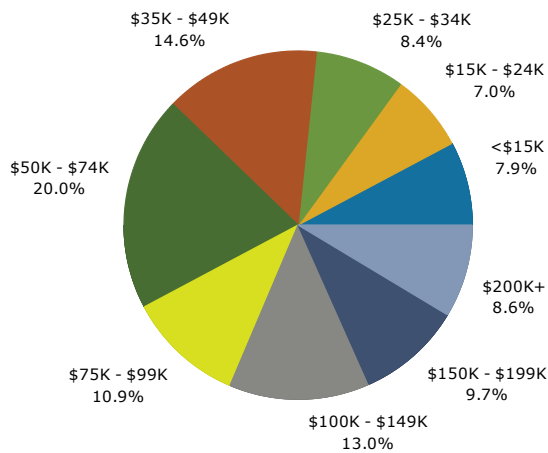
Trends 2023-2028



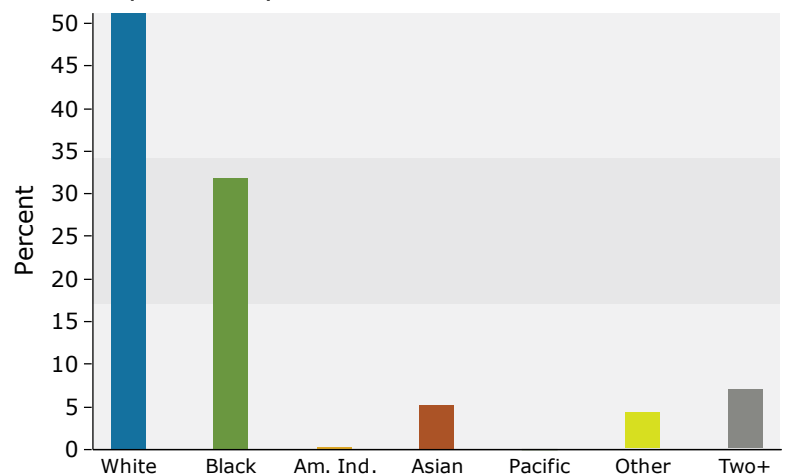
Population by Age

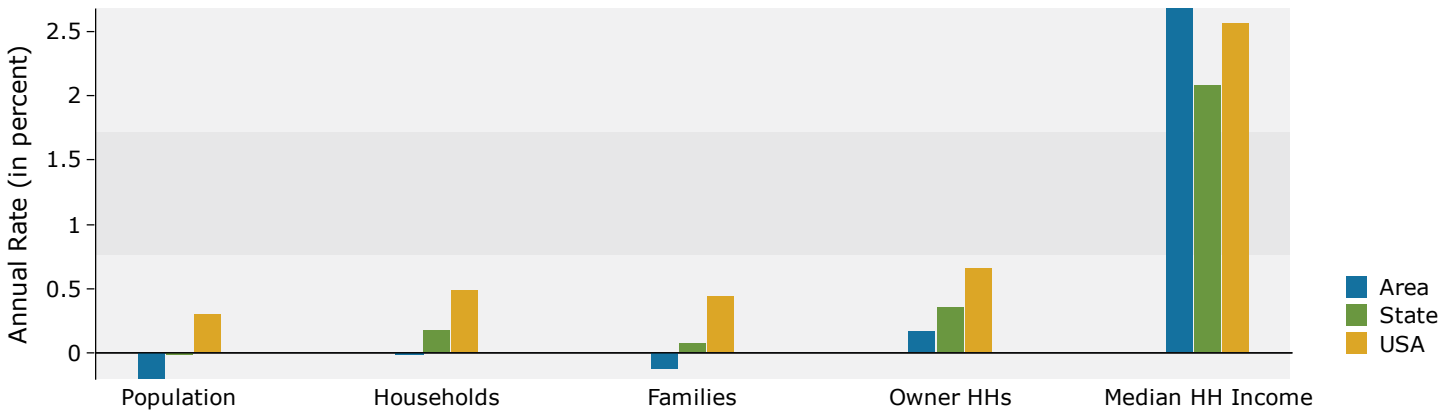

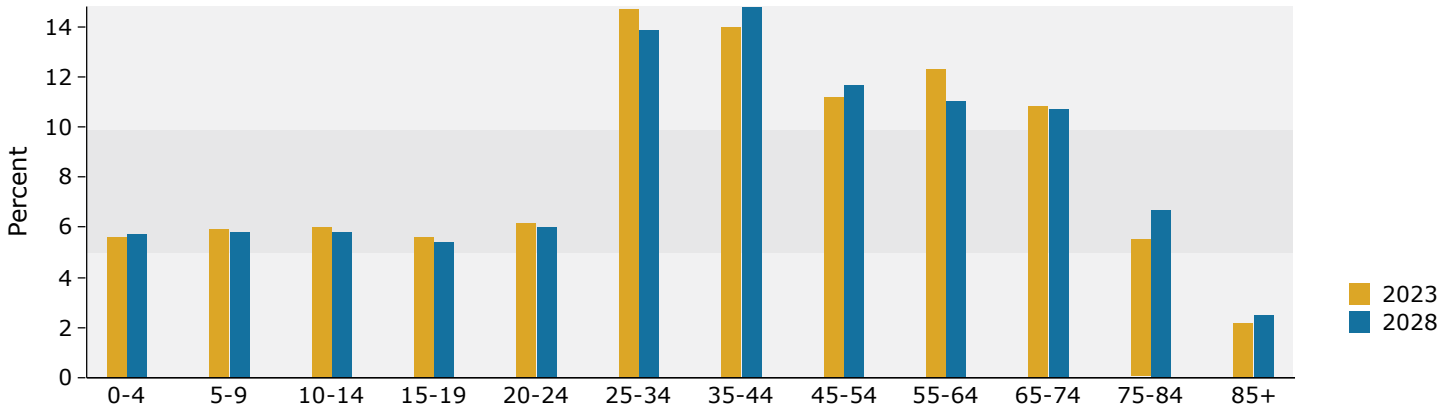

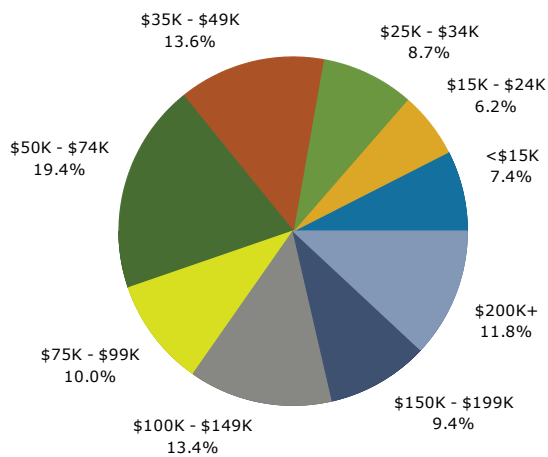
Trends 2023-2028



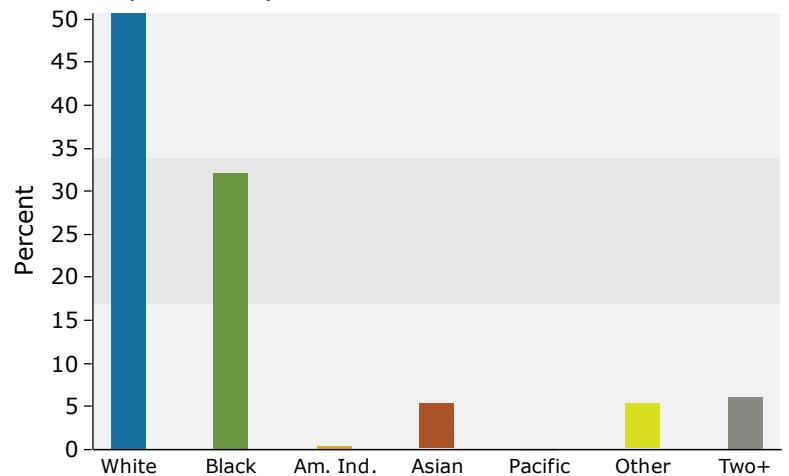
Population by Age
