Offered for lease, this 6,218 SF commercial facility combines finished office space, a substantial shop, mezzanine area, multiple oversized shop doors, outdoor storage, and 18 parking spaces on 1.62 acres. The property is particularly well suited to contractors, trades, service companies, equipment-related businesses, and other users seeking a functional office-and-shop headquarters in Palmer.

LOCATION DESCRIPTION

Located in the Palmer Commercial Center, at 1920 S Eklutna Street, Palmer, AK 99645, this property provides a Palmer base for businesses serving customers and projects throughout the surrounding Mat-Su market. For a contractor, trade, or service company, consolidating administrative staff, field crews, equipment, and storage at a single location can simplify day-to-day coordination and create a more efficient operational hub.

The property's Palmer location also makes it relevant to businesses specifically searching for commercial shop and office space in the Mat-Su Valley while maintaining a professional facility for employees, management, and clients.

SITE DESCRIPTION

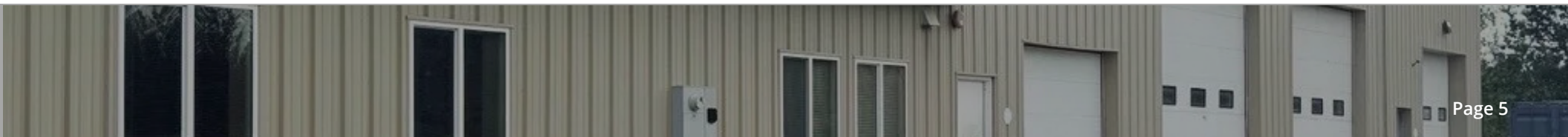
The property offers 6,218 SF of commercial space on approximately 1.62 acres across two lots and is leased together as a single facility.

Approximately 1,850 SF with 10 offices, a conference room, and air conditioning, providing substantial administrative capacity for management, estimating, dispatch, accounting, sales, or project teams.

The property also features an approximately 3,528 SF shop plus mezzanine, providing significant space for equipment, materials, staging, maintenance, or other permitted business operations. Shop ceiling height reaches approximately 20 feet at its high point, enhancing vertical capacity and flexibility.

Multiple overhead doors—including two 14' × 14' doors, one 12' × 12' door, and one 10' × 9' door—provide excellent flexibility for moving vehicles, equipment, deliveries, and materials in and out of the shop.

Two outdoor storage areas expand the property's functionality beyond the building itself, while 18 parking spaces, including one accessible space, support employees, visitors, and day-to-day business activity.

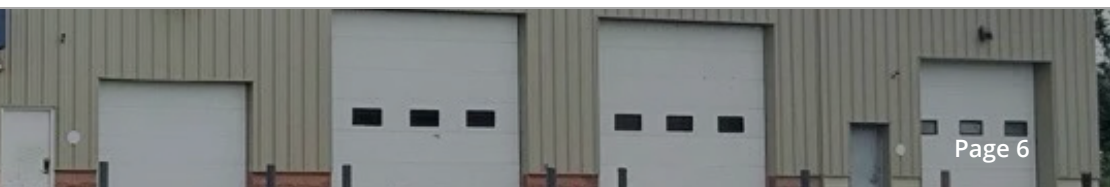

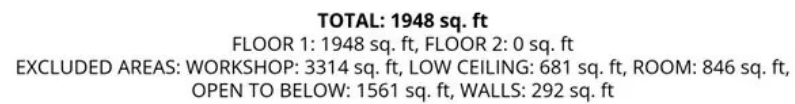
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Location Map

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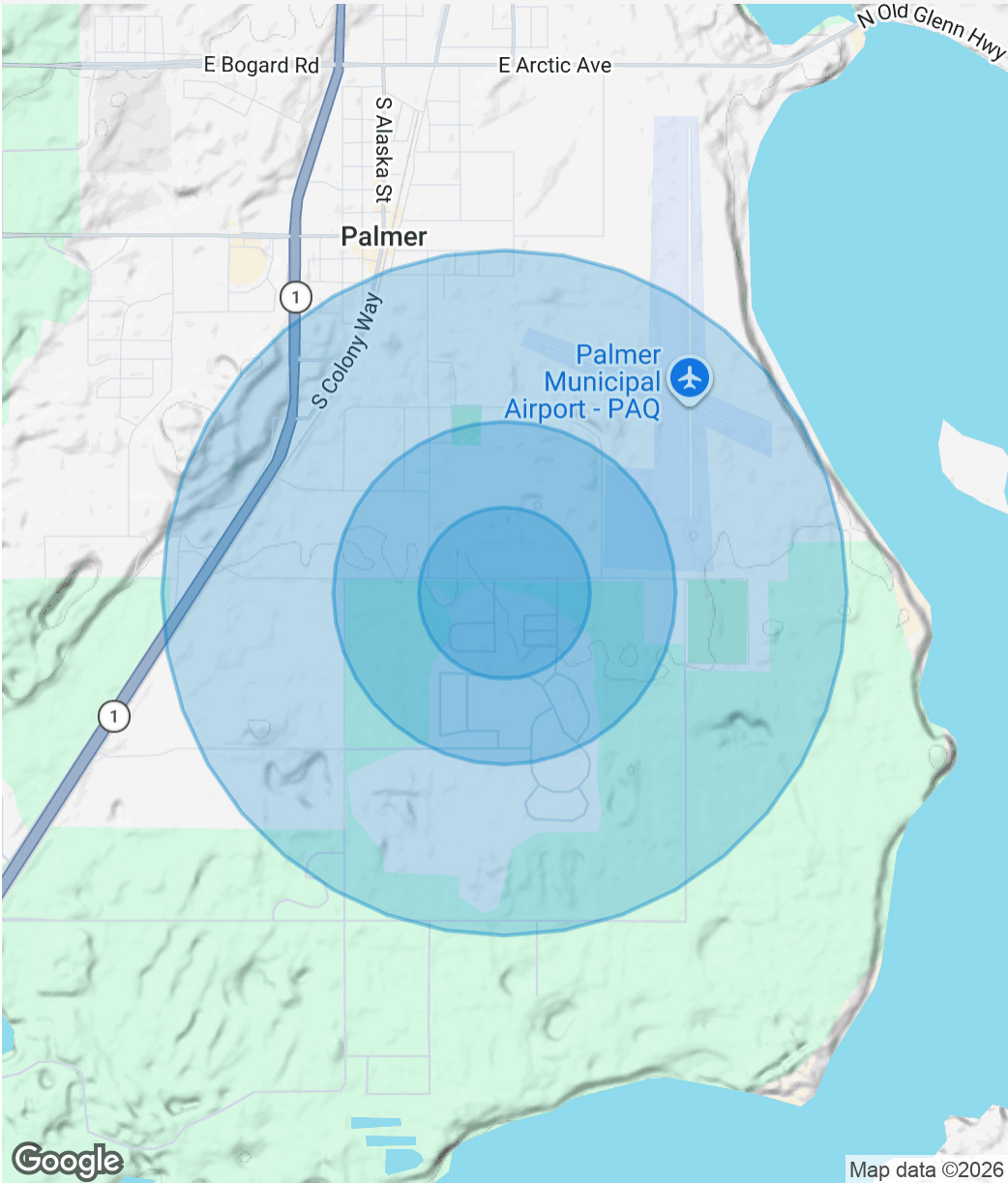
