Outside the farmhouse, the property offers everything needed for both business operations and leisure. The property includes a 1500 sq. ft. operational air-conditioned warehouse, a separate 200 sq. ft. office, as well as 3 exterior walk-in coolers, and 1 interior walk-in cooler(8x8, 20x8, 6x11, 10x11), which are essential for storing fresh produce and other perishable items. A grow room, 1 greenhouses, and 3 high tunnels (16x60, 20x60, 14x50) further support the farm's ability to grow produce using regenerative, no-till, and organic practices nine months out of the year.

The farm's 1-acre market garden is cultivated year-round, supported by high tunnels and greenhouses that allow for extended seasonal production. Local Pumpkin has become well-known for its community-centered approach to agriculture, providing a customizable subscription service with options for weekly, biweekly, or monthly deliveries. Customers enjoy access to over 400 items, including fresh produce, meats, baked goods, dairy, snacks, and meal kits, delivered directly to their door or available for farm pickup.

With a loyal customer base that peaked at around 600 weekly deliveries during the pandemic and now consistently averages 350 deliveries per week, Local Pumpkin continues to target growth, aiming for 500 deliveries per week. Its partnerships with regional farms, artisan producers, and local food vendors—offering everything from grains to ready-made meals—strengthen its commitment to both local economies and sustainable agriculture.
