Firefly Firefly (currently located in Cedar Park) is expanded and moved its headquarters to a 40,000 SF building located next to The Crossover and will create 682 new jobs paying an average salary of \$90,000. Firefly is becoming a leader in the rocket-launch market, having recently successfully delivered payload to the moon. - Hanyang Eng USA, Inc. 2-miles. Engineering consultant Hanyang Eng USA to <u>establish headquarters</u> in Cedar Park. Hanyang Eng USA provides products and engineering services to a variety of industries, including semiconductors, power generation and mechanical engineering
- Enovis, a medical technology company, announced a \$25.5 million expansion in Cedar Park to establish a 100,000-square-foot manufacturing facility, bringing at least 162 new jobs.
- <u>Zeteo Biomedical</u>, a company specializing in biopharmaceutical drug delivery solutions, <u>announced</u> its relocation to Cedar Park.
- <u>Element USA Accelerator Inc.</u>, a mineral extraction and refining company, is setting up a <u>new facility</u> in Cedar Park, bringing innovation and jobs to the area.
- <u>The Crossover</u> 2-miles. The Crossover is over 200,000SF under roof Sports, Wellness and Entertainment venue. Opening November 2021.
- Perfect Game 3-miles. <This project has been delayed due to an Army Corp of Engineers environmental issue> Perfect Game is the world's largest youth baseball and softball platform and scouting service with 95% of all players chosen in the 2021 MLB draft being former Perfect Game participants. This large local economic impact project will bring best-in-class tournaments and result in an estimated 60,000 room nights in year 1 and 150,000 room nights in year

- New Hope Corporate Park Less than 2-miles. The complete development will contain upwards of 500,000 square feet of industrial space on 48 acres of land with plans to build retail and other mixed-use property on another 40 acres of land. Per a news release, the project will cost \$250 million.

- <u>Bell District</u> Less than 2-miles with Estimated Project Cost = \$350M: This is a 50-acre public/private partnership that will feature mixed-use development filled with local restaurants, retail and recreation options. Rerouting of Hwy 183 (Bell Blvd) for this project was completed in Q1-2022. The first buildings delivered in late 2024.

There is an outdoor stage that will provide live entertainment. Open February 2023. The first year was a slow start, but in 2024 Spare Birdie seems to have found its groove.
- WorldSprings Less than 2-miles. The world's greatest mineral waters, all in one place. Explore over 40 mineral hot springs with temperatures from the mid 80's to the low 100's, and refreshing cold plunges at 55'F.
