



New PackEx facility to enhance Marianna's economy and eco-focus

PackEx USA is bringing a \$50 million investment to **Jackson County**, opening a 400,000 sq. ft. aluminum bottling facility in **Marianna**. The project will create **75 jobs** and focus on **sustainability**, with plans to partner with local schools and reduce energy use through renewables.

As one of the few aluminum fillers on the East Coast, PackEx will serve major beverage brands and cruise lines, with 80% of capacity already committed. The facility opens **January 1** and marks a big step forward in clean, local manufacturing.
