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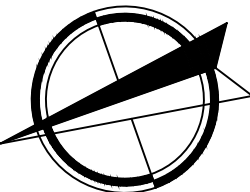

Location, Location, Location!

It doesn't get much better than Seneca Falls. Situated at the northern end of Cayuga Lake, we're a convenient 45 minute drive to three major metro areas: Rochester, Syracuse, and Ithaca.

We're minutes from the New York State Thruway, close to the Cayuga and Seneca Wine Trails, central to eight major colleges and universities, within an hour of two international airports, and have six major State routes which have seen substantial annual traffic increases.



Wellness and Recreation



From one of the finest recreational centers in the area to the many outdoor options on and off the water, residents and visitors alike can maintain happy, healthy bodies that are ready for their next adventure.

The Seneca Falls Community Recreation Center (pictured above) is a 21,800 square-foot facility located one block from the Women's Rights National Historic Monument. The ADA-accessible, air-conditioned indoor gymnasium includes a full-sized basketball court for tournament play, two cross-court basketball and volleyball courts, and plenty of room to handle community events. The center also features a multi-use activity room, a diverse fitness area, a game room, public lounge, and large south-facing windows that overlook the water.
